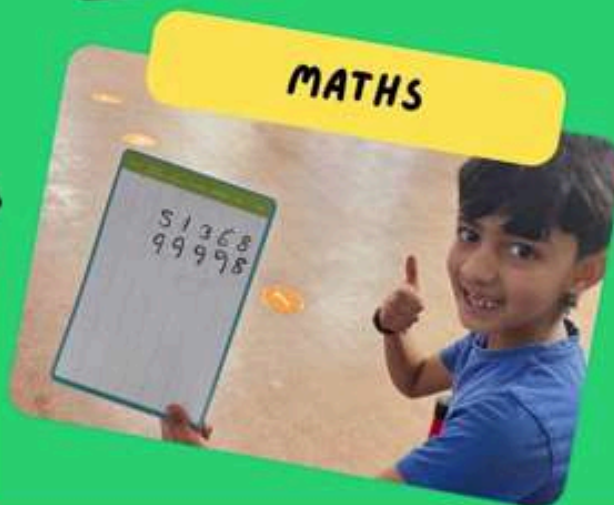

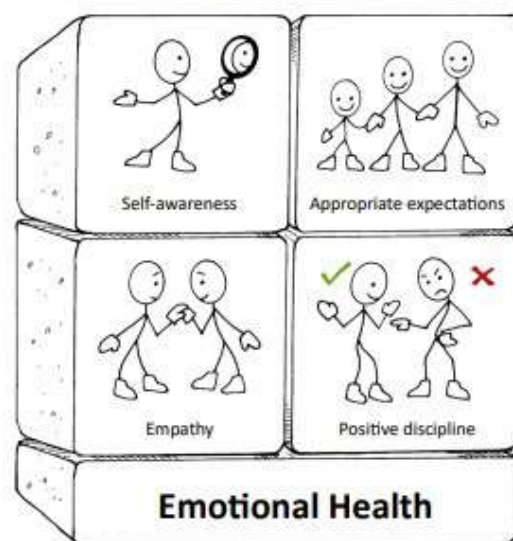

The Four Constructs of the Nurturing Programme



Cost: If you're aged 19+ and live or work in Cambridgeshire as of 31 August 2025, you may be eligible for full funding (no fee)

if you meet one of the following:

- Ordinarily resident in the UK on the first day of learning
- Unemployed or earning less than £30,491/year (Cambridgeshire & Peterborough)
- Earning less than £25,750/year (non-devolved UK areas)

Otherwise, fees may apply (up to £64)
