

What is an Imaginarium I hear you ask. Its a fun space where you can think about what you'd like for the future of Histon and Impington. Everyone is welcome, it's free, just drop-in during the afternoon, we need you all! Do you have ideas and longings for you and your family's life and future in the village that you'd like to share? Would you like to talk them through with local scientists, architects, farmers, neighbours, artists, engineers, naturalists and councillors.

If so please join us for H&I's first Imaginarium – a fun, creative and thought-provoking event that can help busy people living in challenging times think about and imagine positive futures. On Sat 7th Feb, 1-4pm at the St Andrew's Centre we're offering absolutely everyone the time and space to visualise how our village might look and feel in 10 year's time. You'll be invited to enter the 'HI Time Machine' and then draw from the 'Pool of Possibility' before coming together with others to explore all aspects of our lives; how we might play, travel, live alongside nature, how our homes might look, what our diet might be like and where our food will come from. How we might live well with less stuff, have better health and greater connection across the generations.

All the ideas will be used to create a directory of ideas, the event will be filmed, and all materials created during the event will be collected into a display. This will make a record of the conversations, the evidence if you like, that can be used to influence decisions made by councils and groups that work in and for our villages.

School groups and the uniformed brigades have been engaging with the Imaginarium over recent weeks, please come and see what they've come up with. This free event is for all and we welcome small ideas and huge ones, sensible ones and fantastical ones! Please join us to nourish the ambitions of our community, to tap into a sense of what's possible and feel hopeful. It's hard to build a different future if we can't imagine how it will look and feel.



In September 2024 we launched the brand new Bottisham Music Centre (BMC) based at Bottisham Village College. BMC is open to all budding musicians currently in school years 3-7. Our holiday workshops cater for all abilities, from complete beginners to experienced musicians, and we are pleased to announce that booking is now available for our February half-term course (Monday 16 and Tuesday 17 February).

This is a 2-day course in which students will take part in workshop sessions that will develop a wide range of music making skills and provide opportunities to learn and perform with other young musicians. Many of our groups cater for complete beginners, whilst others require some experience. Our balanced programme ensures that we are able cater for everyone. The workshop will culminate in a performance to family and friends to showcase our work at the end of the second day.

Music sessions will be led by the Bottisham Music Centre team who are all experienced musicians and educators. The following sessions are available at our February workshop. Choose one activity from each group.

Group A

- **Rock School** (Keyboard, Guitar/Ukulele, Bass, Drums): Work on playing a popular song to perform alongside Rock choir
- **Rock Choir**: Sing as a group with our Rock School band

Group B

- **Body Percussion**: Making rhythmic music using different body sounds
- **Improver Keyboards**: Group keyboard session. Min 6 months experience required
- **Harmony Choir**: Learn to sing in parts or learn simple harmonies
- **Rhythm Cups**: Creating fun rhythmic patterns using cups

- **Improver Recorders:** Group session. Descant & treble recorders. Must know BAG&E

Group C

- **Orchestra:** For players of brass, strings, woodwind or percussion.
- **Beginner Keyboards:** For complete beginners or recently started – 12 spaces
- **Solo Singing:** Sing a solo line or two in a group song – 12 spaces
- **Samba Drumming:** Rhythmic patterns and movement using drums and percussion
- **Beginner Bass:** For those new to bass guitar – 4 spaces

Group D

- **Djembe Drumming:** Group African drumming patterns
- **Tuned Percussion:** Learn to play melodic parts using a range of tuned percussion instruments eg. Glockenspiels, Chime bars or ~~Boomwhackers~~
- **Musical Theatre Choir:** Sing songs from your favourite musicals
- **Ukulele:** Learn to play the first few chords
- **Improver Bass:** For those with experience or tried previous bass tasters – 4 spaces
