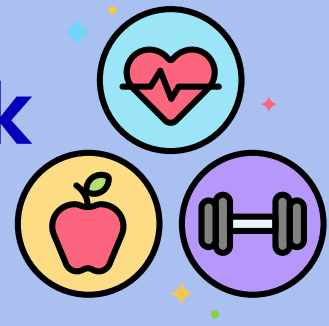
## **Parent survey**

# Healthy Week



Next week all year groups will be taking part in our annual 'Healthy Week'.

We are all very excited about the activities we have planned. You will see over the next few pages the activities your child will be doing on each day. We have some visitors booked to lead workshops with the children, along with special activities planned in the classrooms.

Your child will be taking part in a range of physical activity from Tuesday to Thursday. Please ensure they are in their PE Kit Tuesday-Friday. For Nursery children they need to be in PE kit on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday.



During the Autumn term we won an online social media competition with Giant Journey's. As a result of winning we received a voucher worth £300 towards an immersive experience in school. On Monday and Tuesday the children will use Virtual Reality head sets as they explore the human body.

On Tuesday and Thursday we will be learning to Street Dance with Sara from SJ School of Dance.
