Just to remind you that your child's report is available for you to view on MCAS. On the home page there should be a 'reports' box for you to download the report.



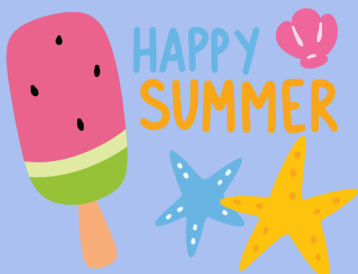

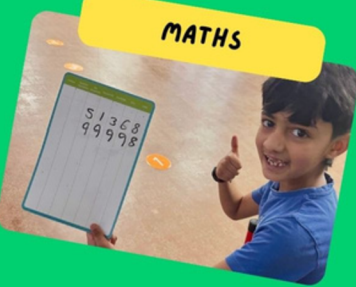
