



Of how she'd tried their porridge...




...and why she'd run away.



Red Riding Hood said, "Are you feeling hungry? Would you like a bun?"






But as she laid the picnic cloth,

They ran and hid beside the pond.




Then Goldilocks gave a cry!

was the wild wolf's winking eye!




"I know," said Goldilocks.
"Let's take cover here."






But, over by the gate, they saw
the wolf's brown pointed ear!


“Let’s go!” they cried. “The riverbank
has trees to hide beneath!”






But peeping through the rustling leaves
they saw the wolf's sharp teeth!


Goldilocks said, "Follow me!
We'll race towards that farm."




“We’ll try and find the Three Bears there

She lives really very near.”




But, as they ran, they heard a howl,

Don’t leave me all alone.”






“No one wants to be my friend.
I’m always on my own!”


“I’m just a friendly, gentle wolf.
I’m really very meek.”




