

HOMework POLICY

At Crosshall Infant School Academy Trust we view homework as being a supported or independent task which is undertaken outside of curriculum time and which reinforces, extends, or enriches current learning.

The purpose of homework:

- To extend school learning, broaden the context of learning and provide enrichment and extension.
- To enable children to practise and consolidate skills.
- To encourage children, as they get older, to develop confidence and self-discipline to study on their own.
- To enable Parents/Carers to become actively involved in their children's learning.

Homework Activities:

The homework set consists of:

- **Reception**- Daily reading
- **Year 1**- Daily reading. Spelling and maths skills are sent home on a weekly basis for the children to practise and learn.
- **Year 2** - Daily reading. Spelling and maths skills are sent home on a weekly basis for the children to practise and learn.

As far as possible we try to keep a regular pattern for setting homework to enable parents and children to establish a familiar routine.

Special Educational Needs:

It is felt that some children may benefit from doing additional or more varied activities at home. The school has a wide range of resources available to support these children. Usually the class teachers approach any parents of children who would benefit from additional activities.
