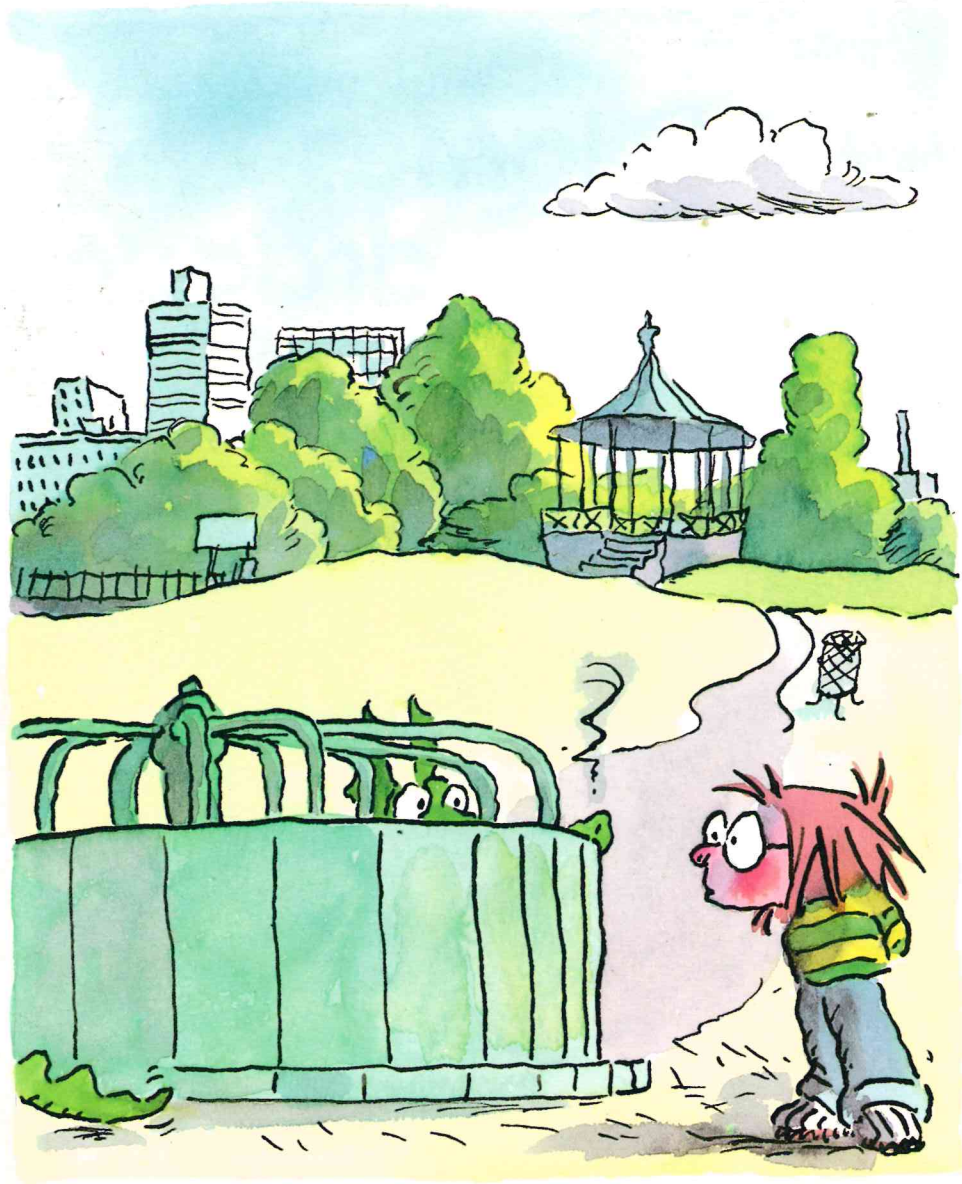

James liked dragons, so he took it home.



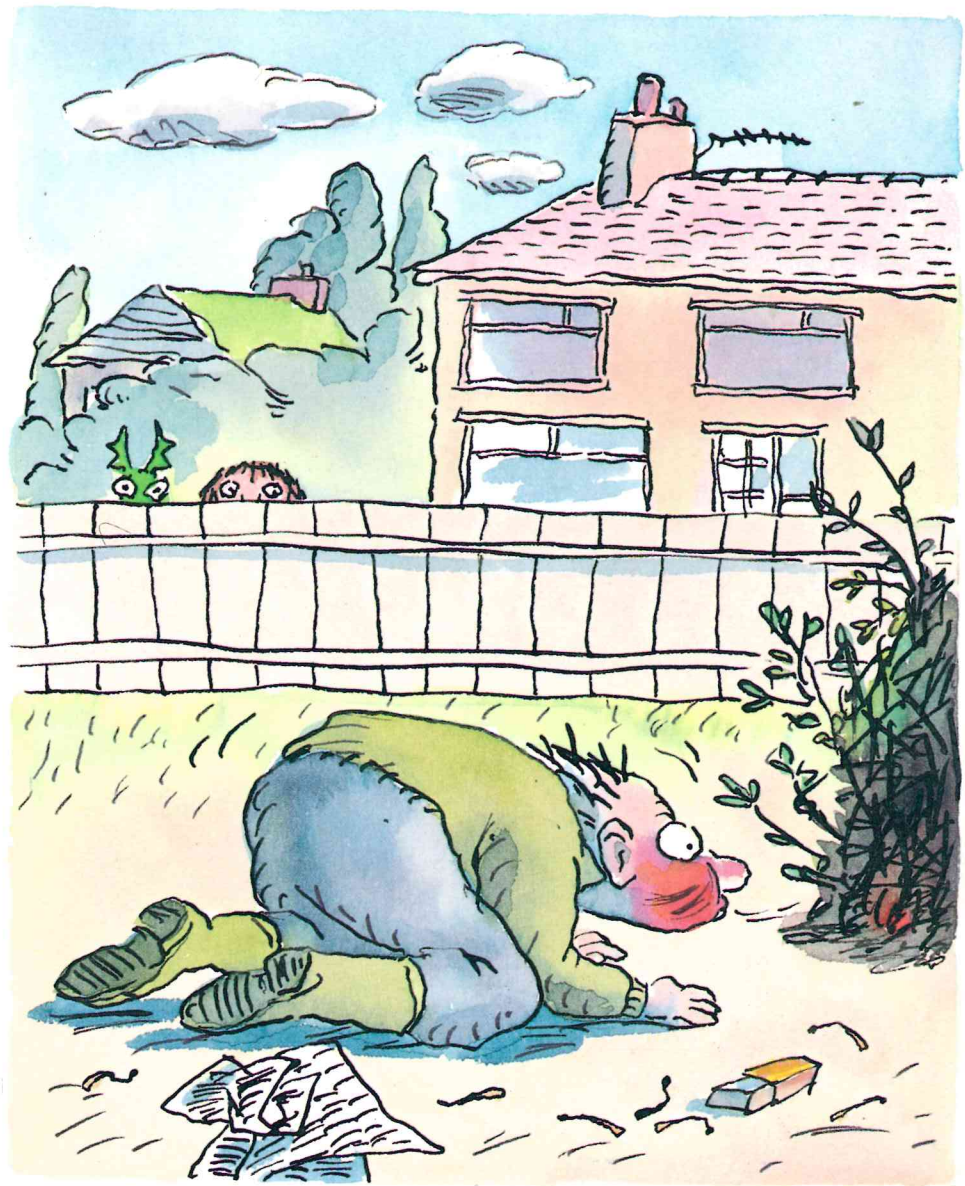
"Mum, look at my dragon," he said.

But Dad said, "Later James."



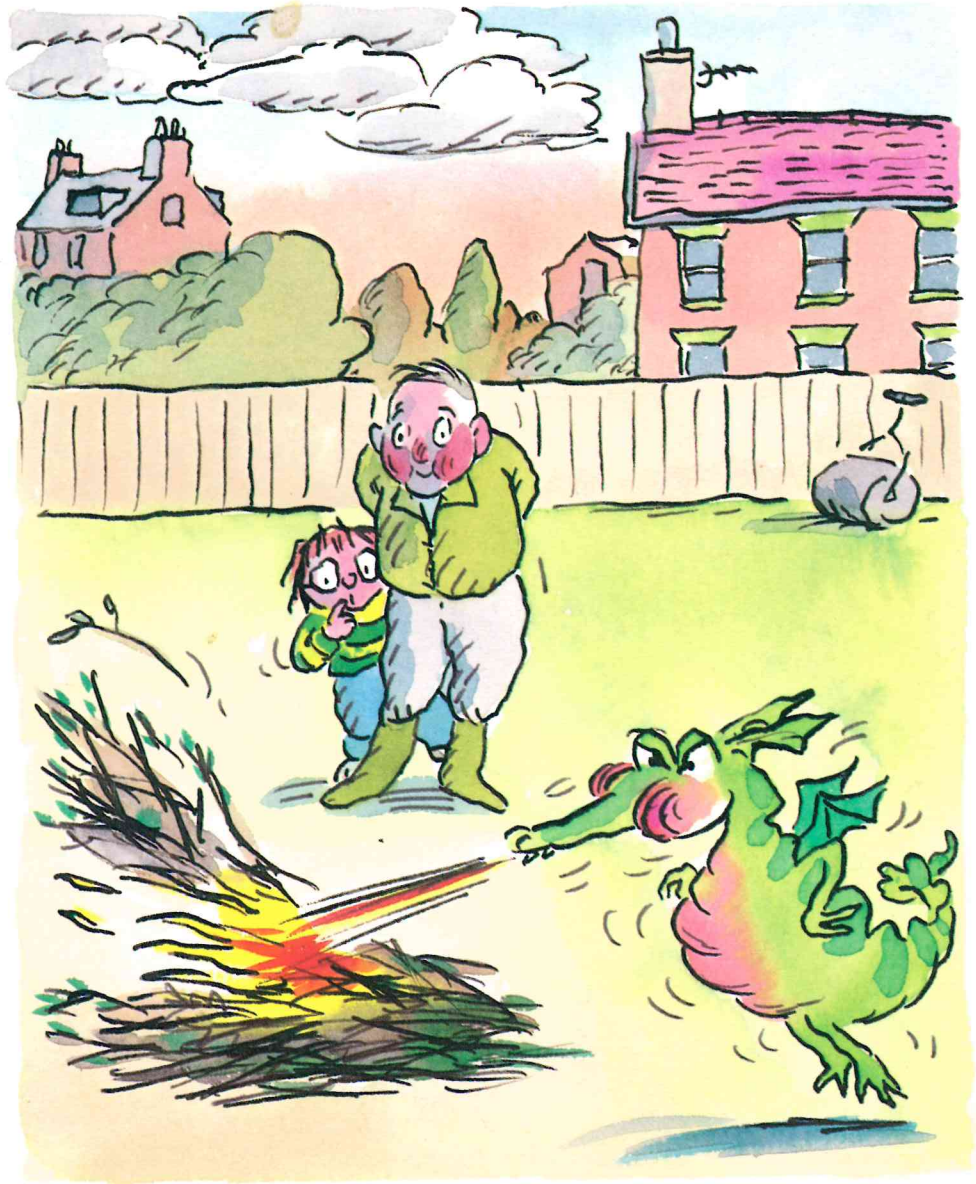
James and the dragon went for a walk.

He was trying to light a fire.



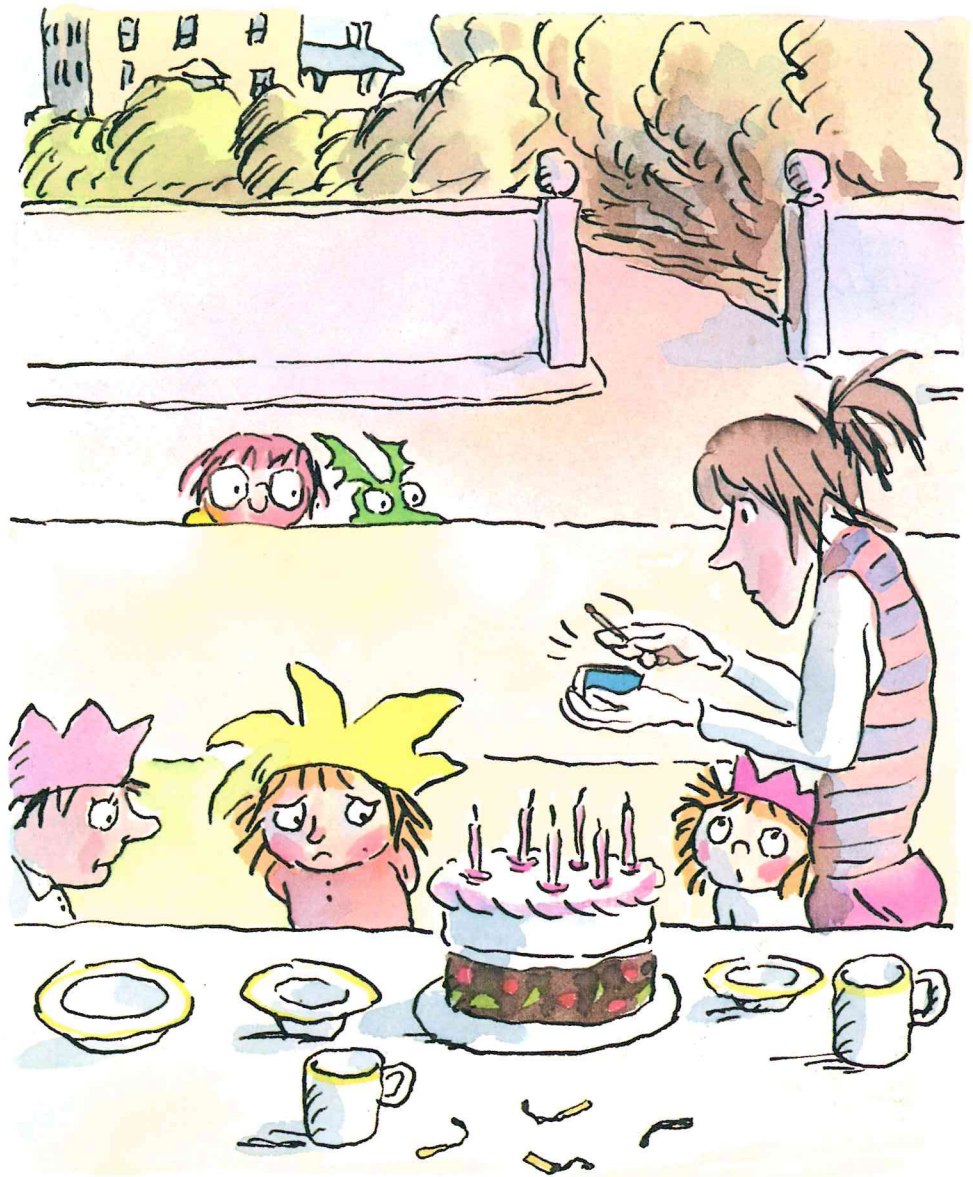
"Can my dragon help?" said James.

"Yes, please," said the girl.



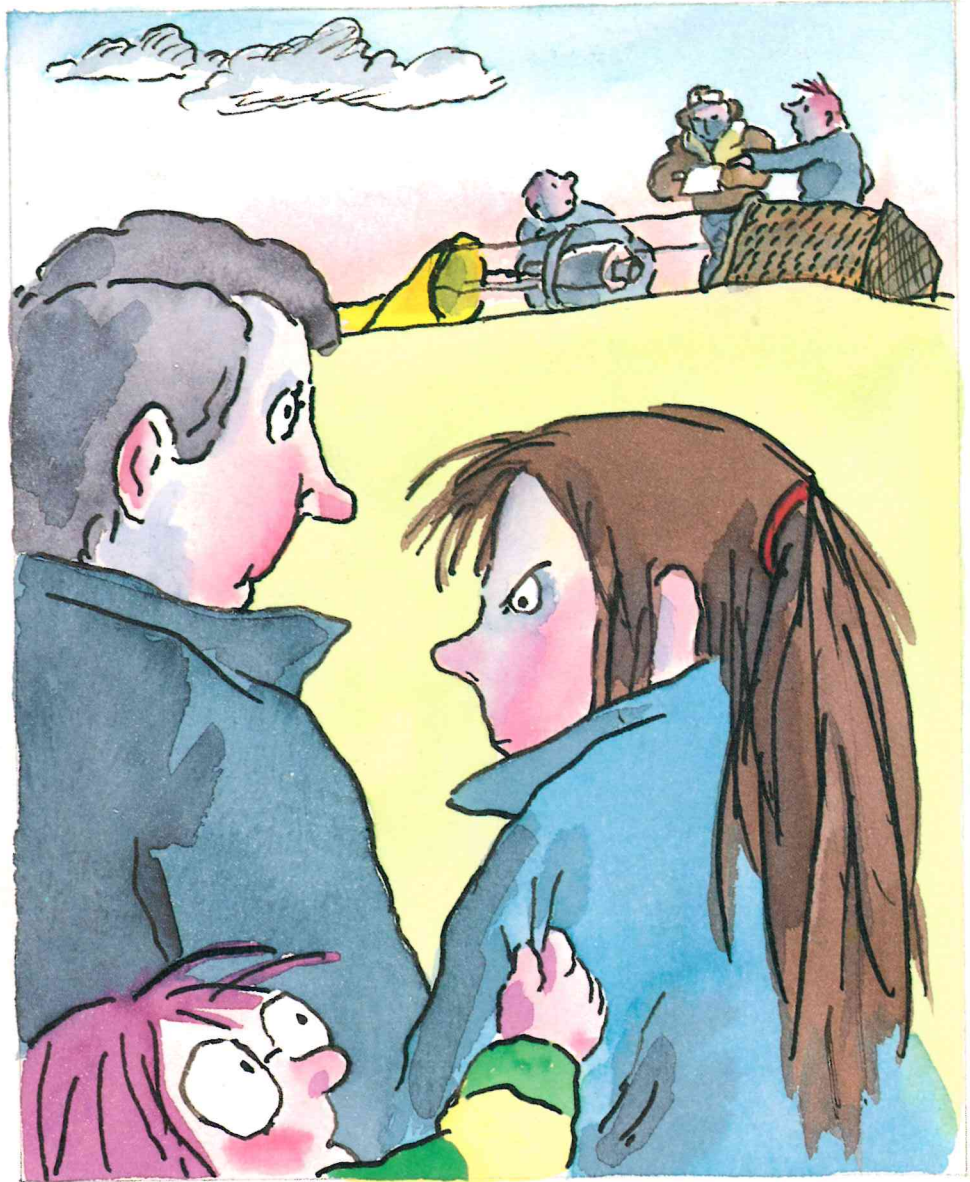
The dragon lit the candles.

"Later, James. Later," they said.



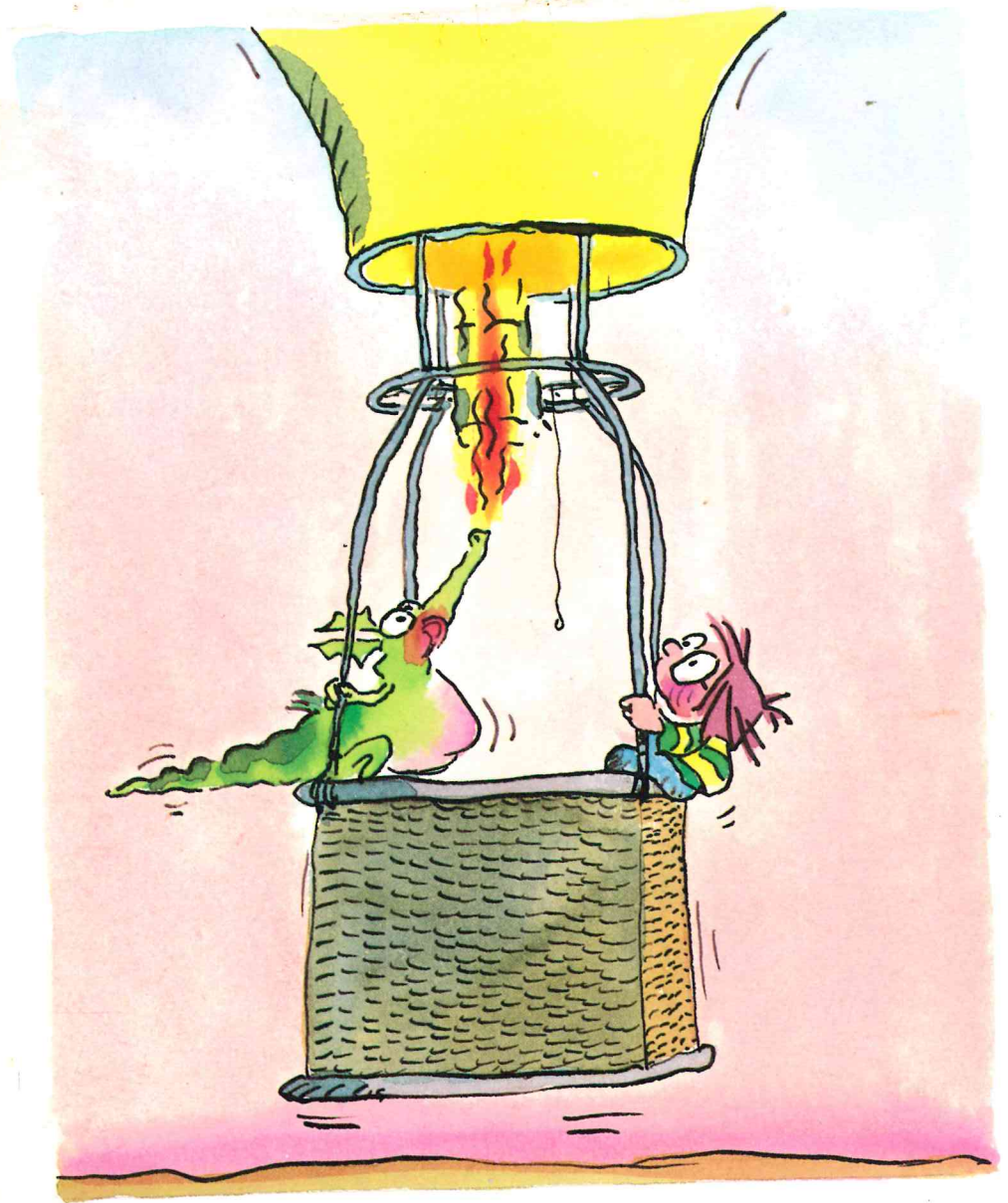
James and the dragon went to look at the balloon. A man was trying to light its fire.



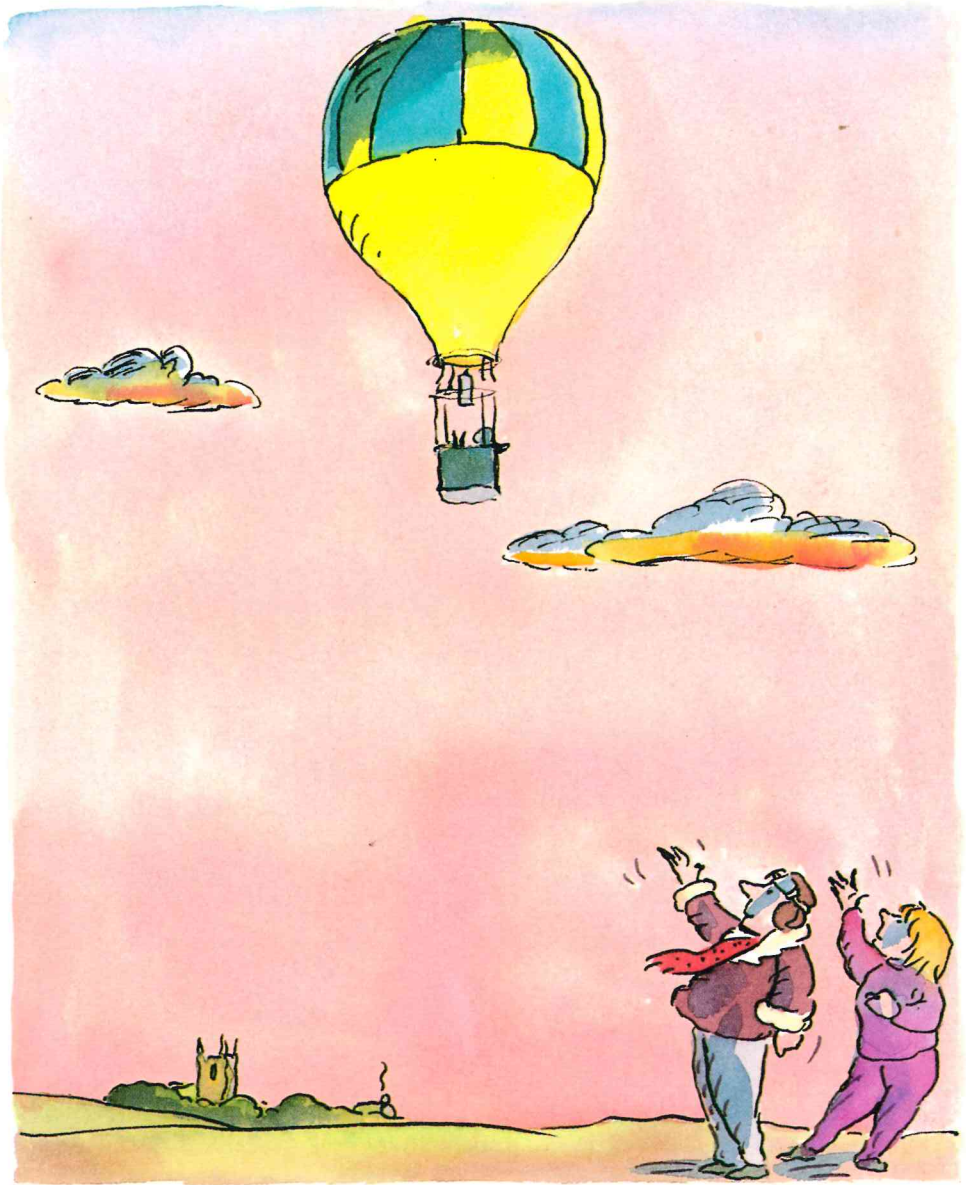
"Can my dragon help?" said James.

So James and the dragon got in the balloon.



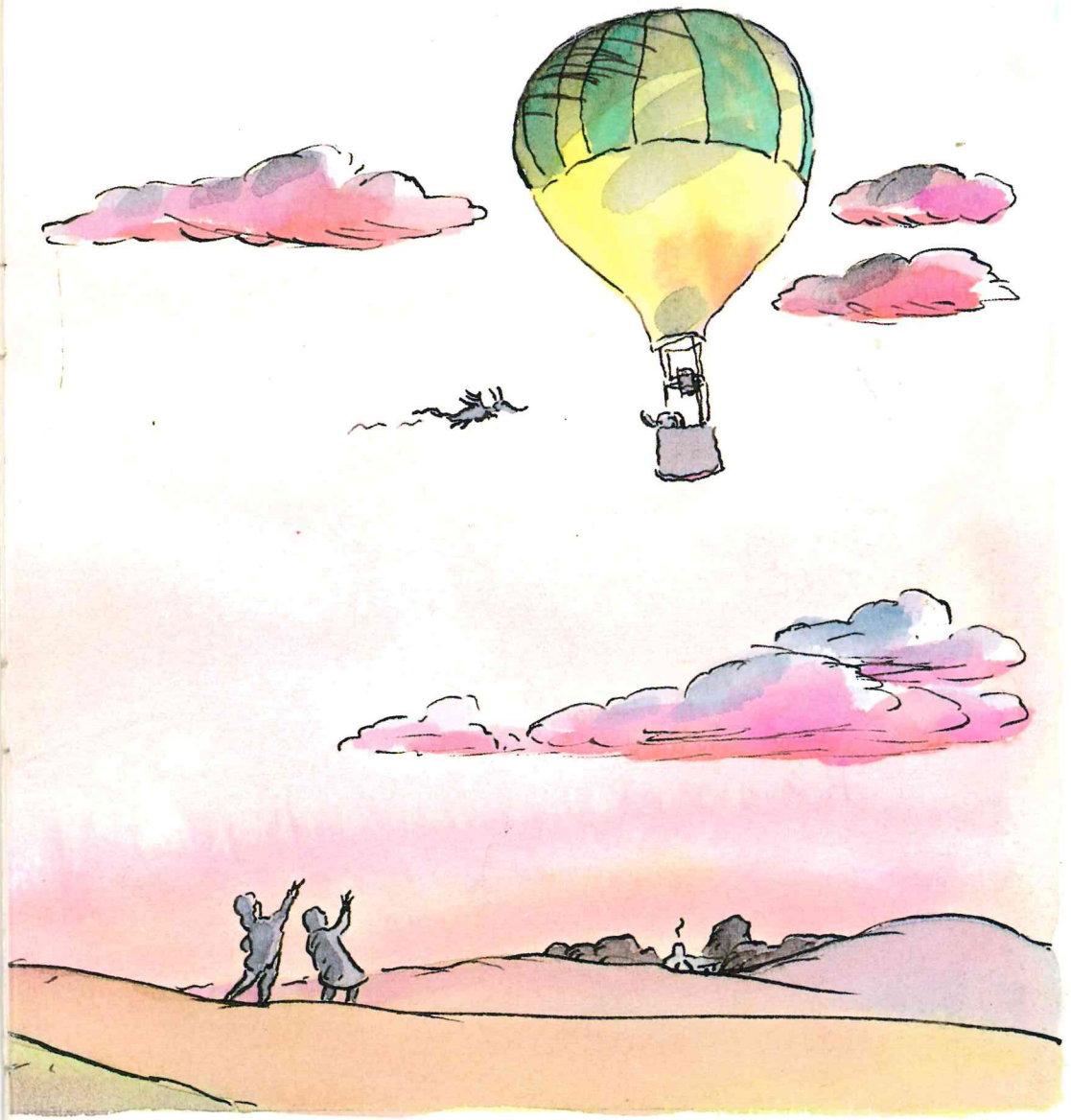
The dragon lit the fire and up they went.



Up and up they went.

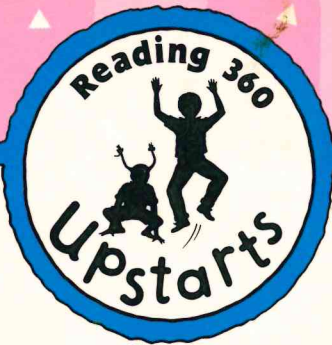


"There's James," said his Mum.

"Come down!" they shouted.





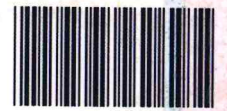
James and the dragon didn't come down.
