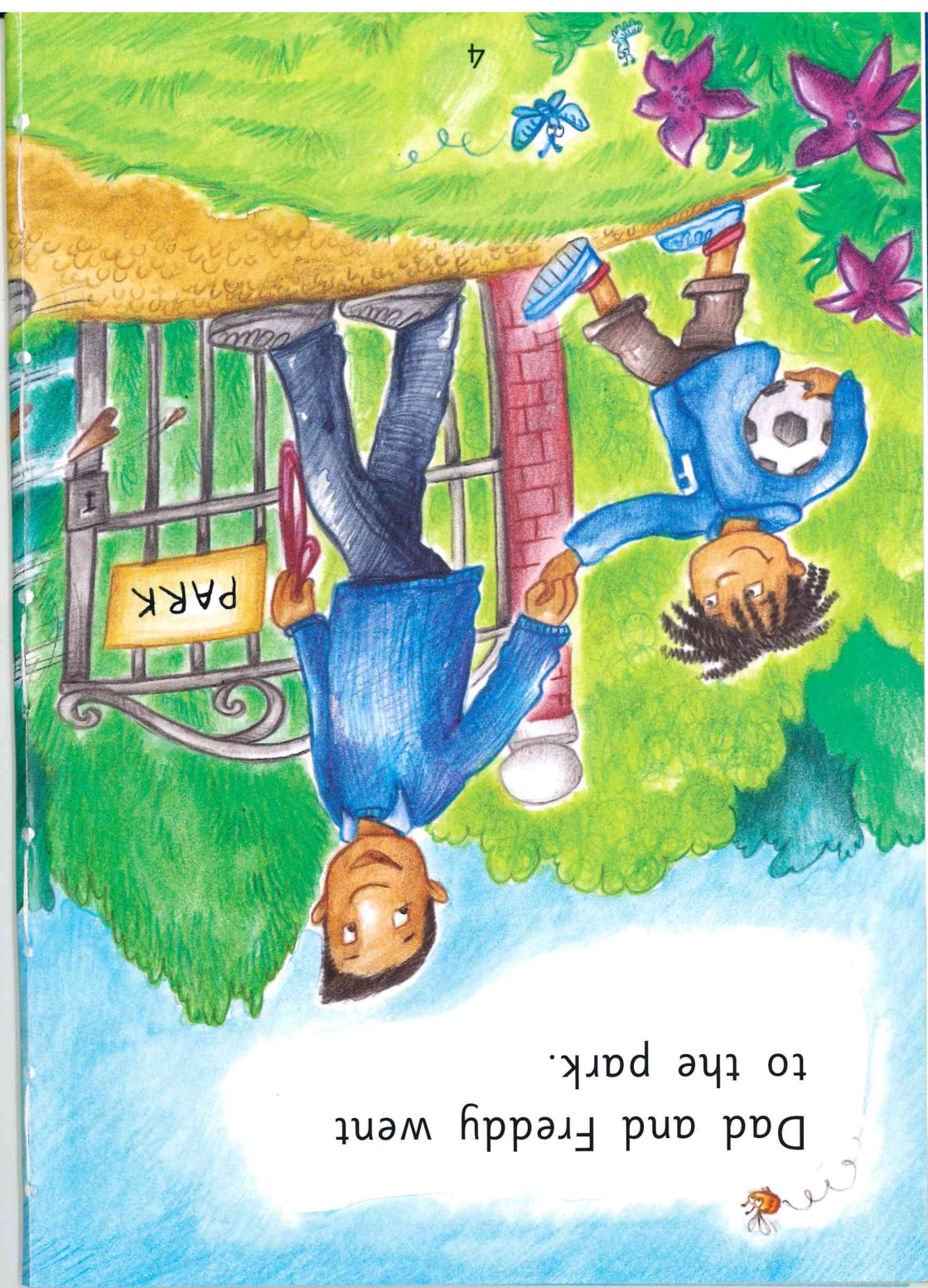

Freddy scored two goals!

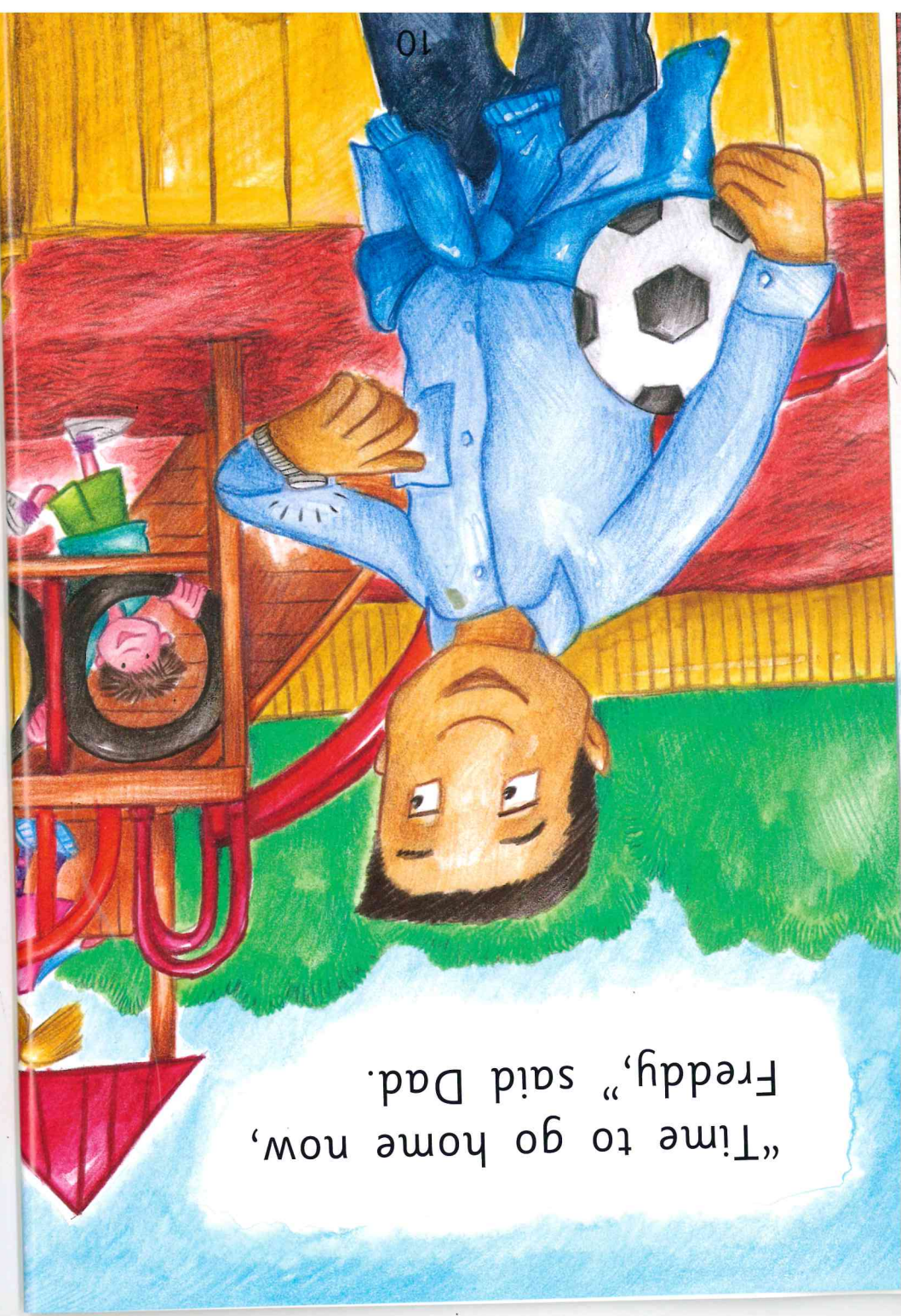


They had a game of football.

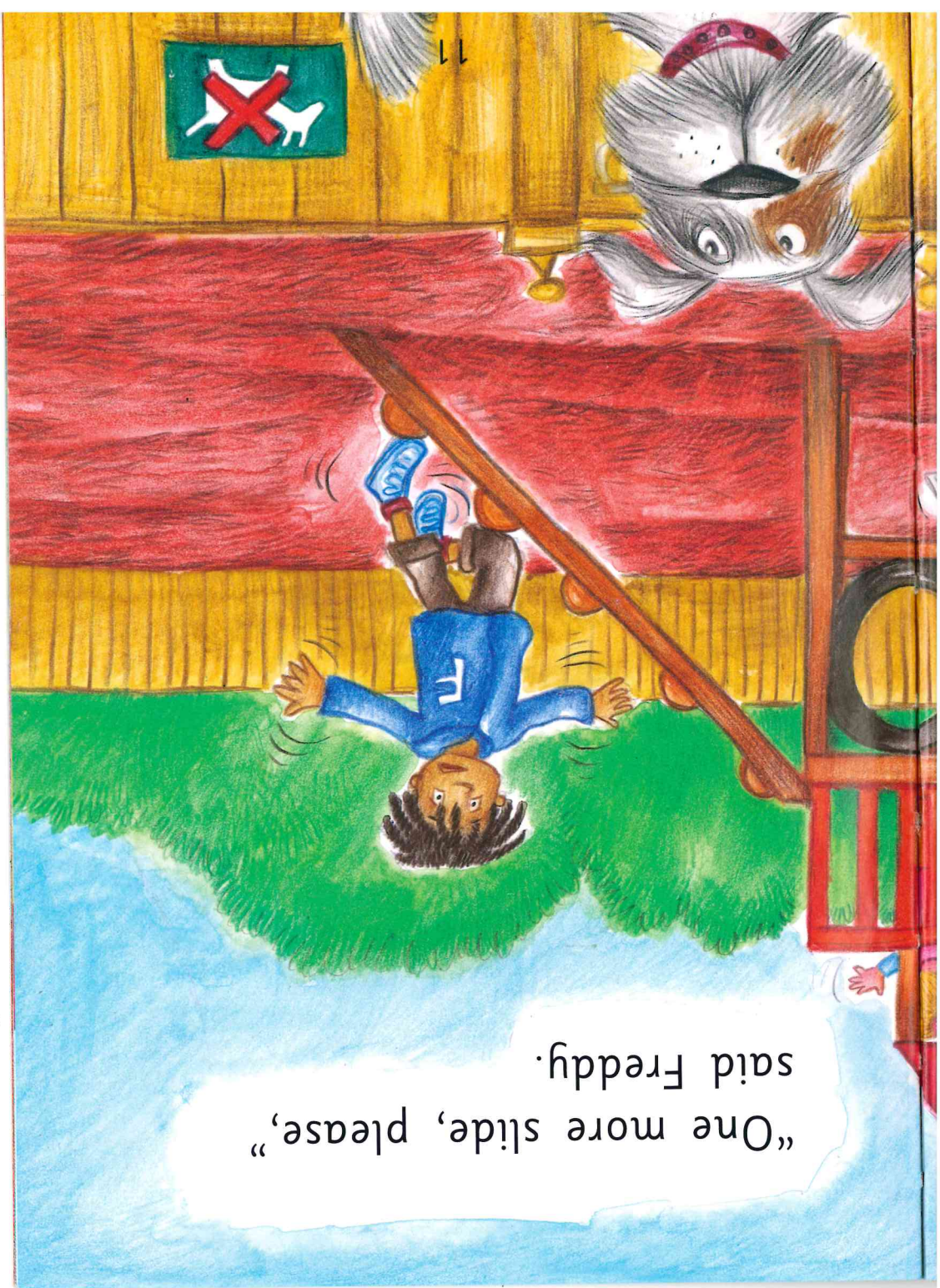


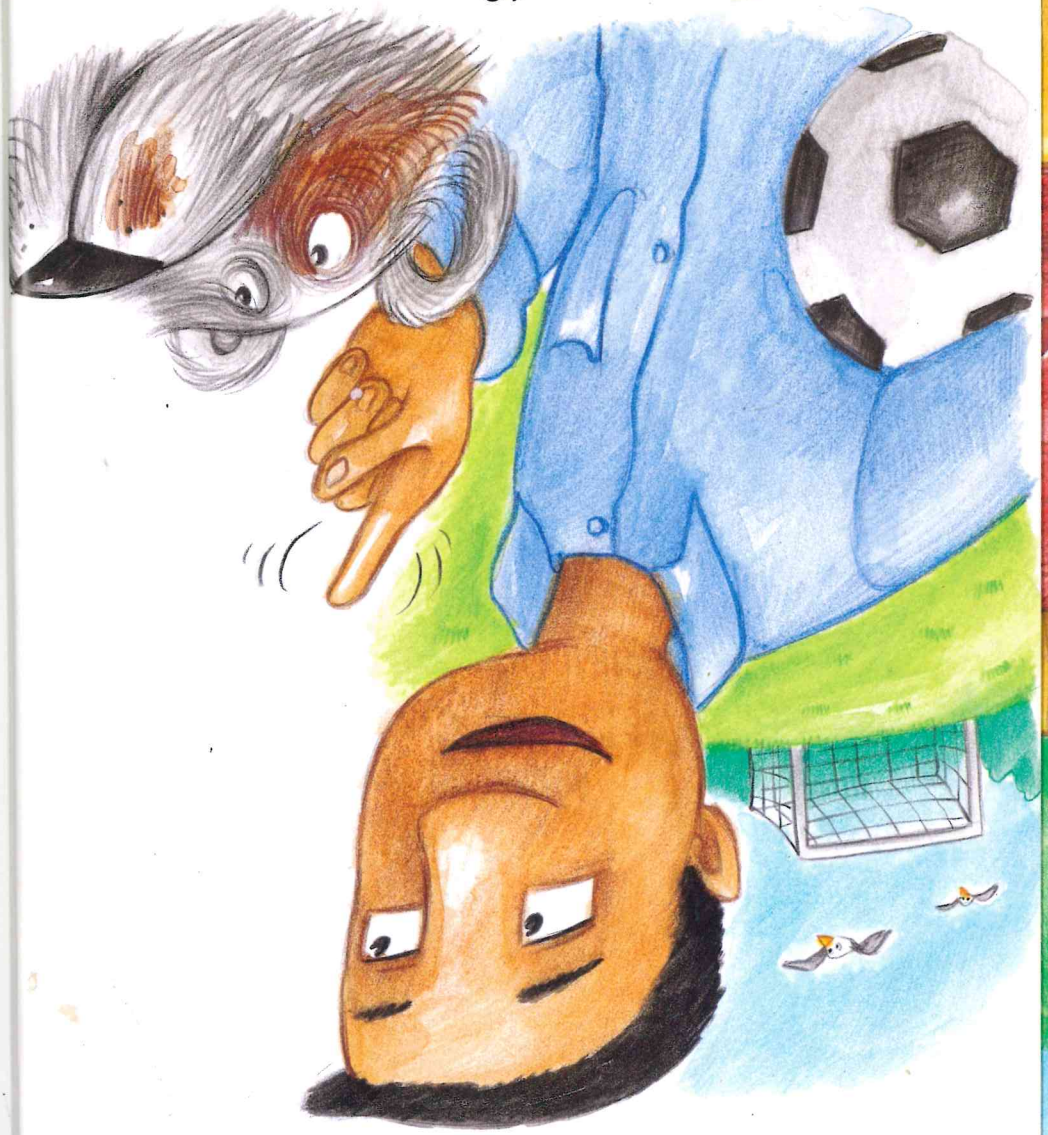
Then he went on the slide.

said Freddy.



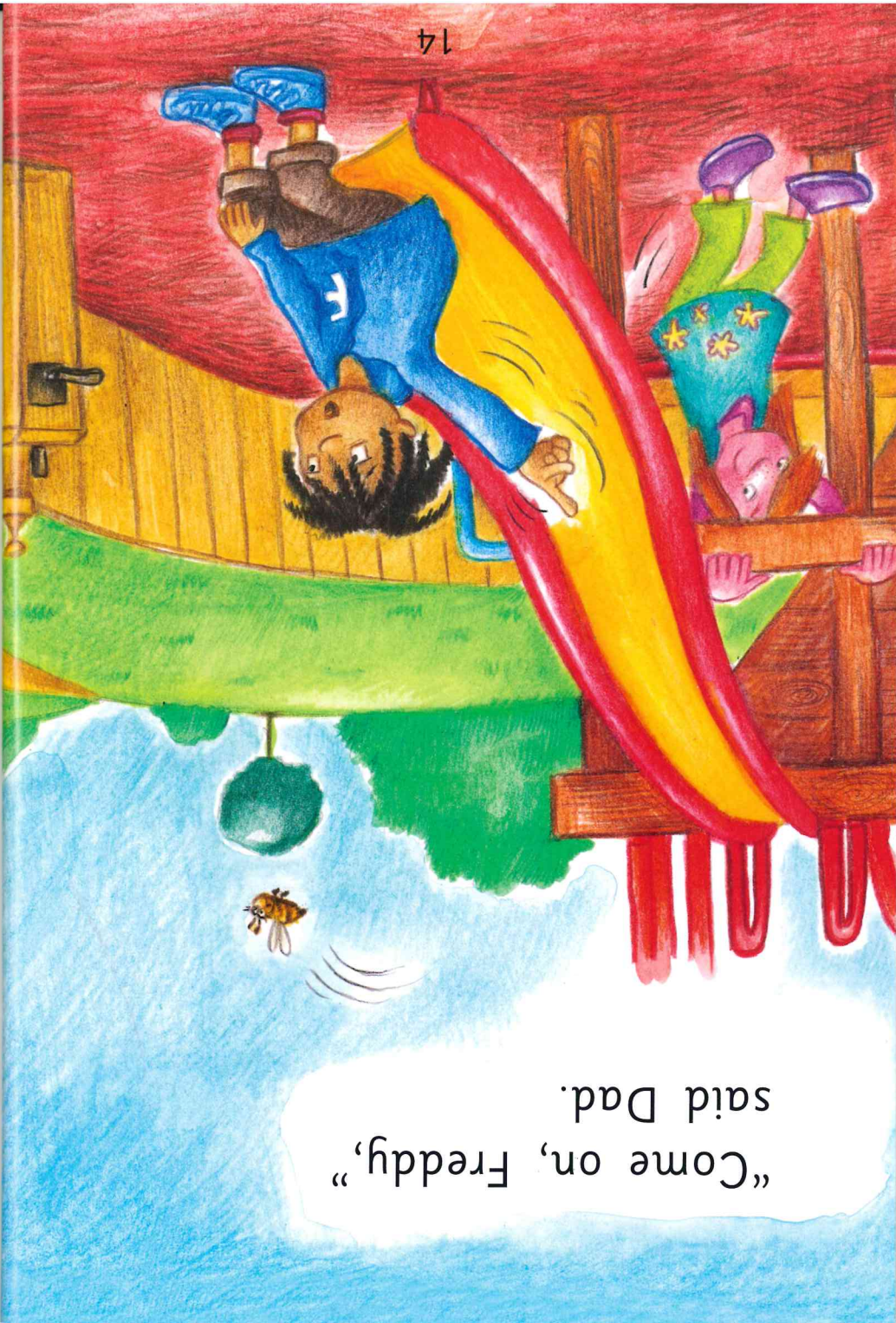


“Just one,” said Dad.

Freddy slid down.



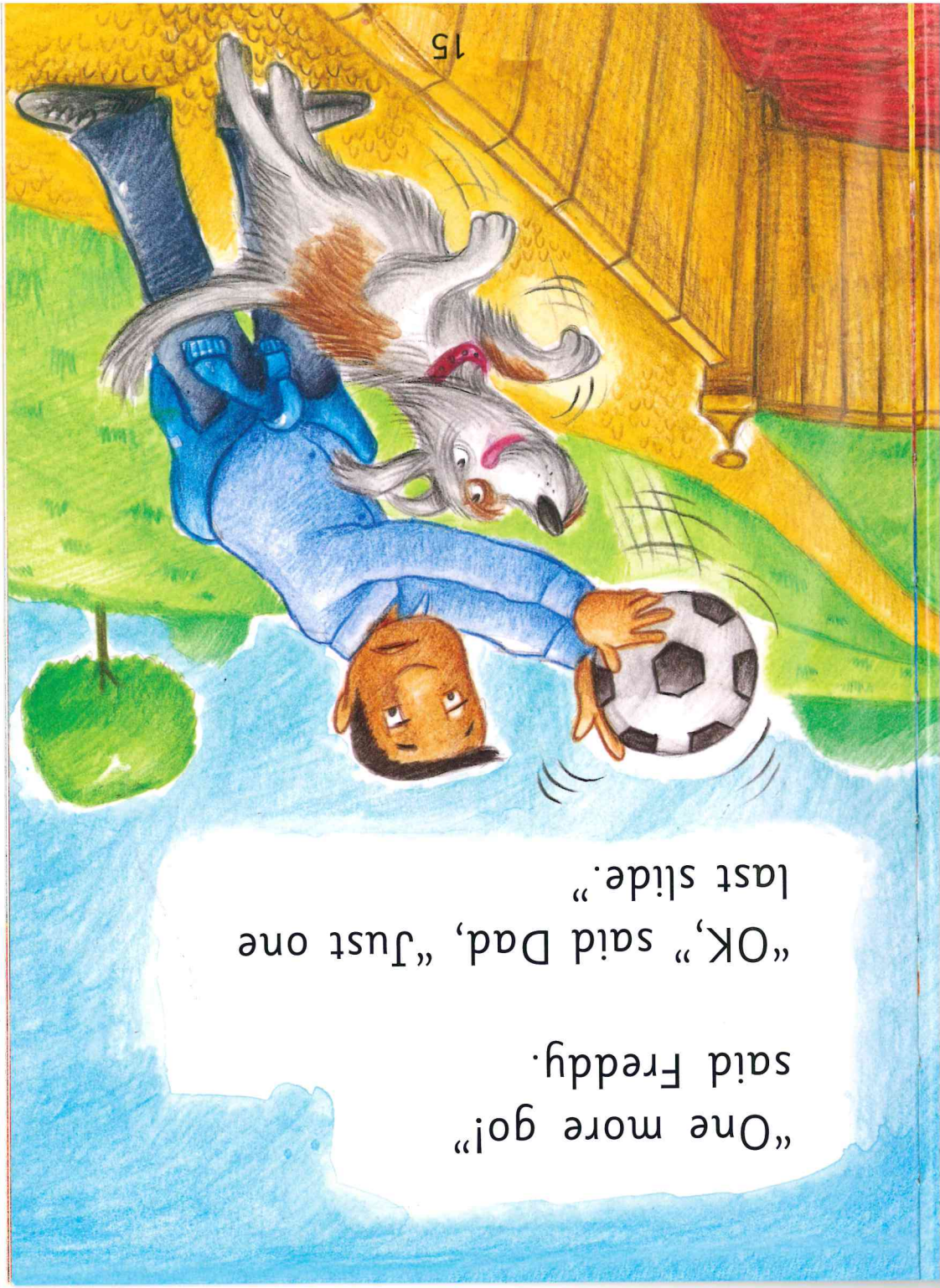
“Hurray!” he shouted.

said Freddy.

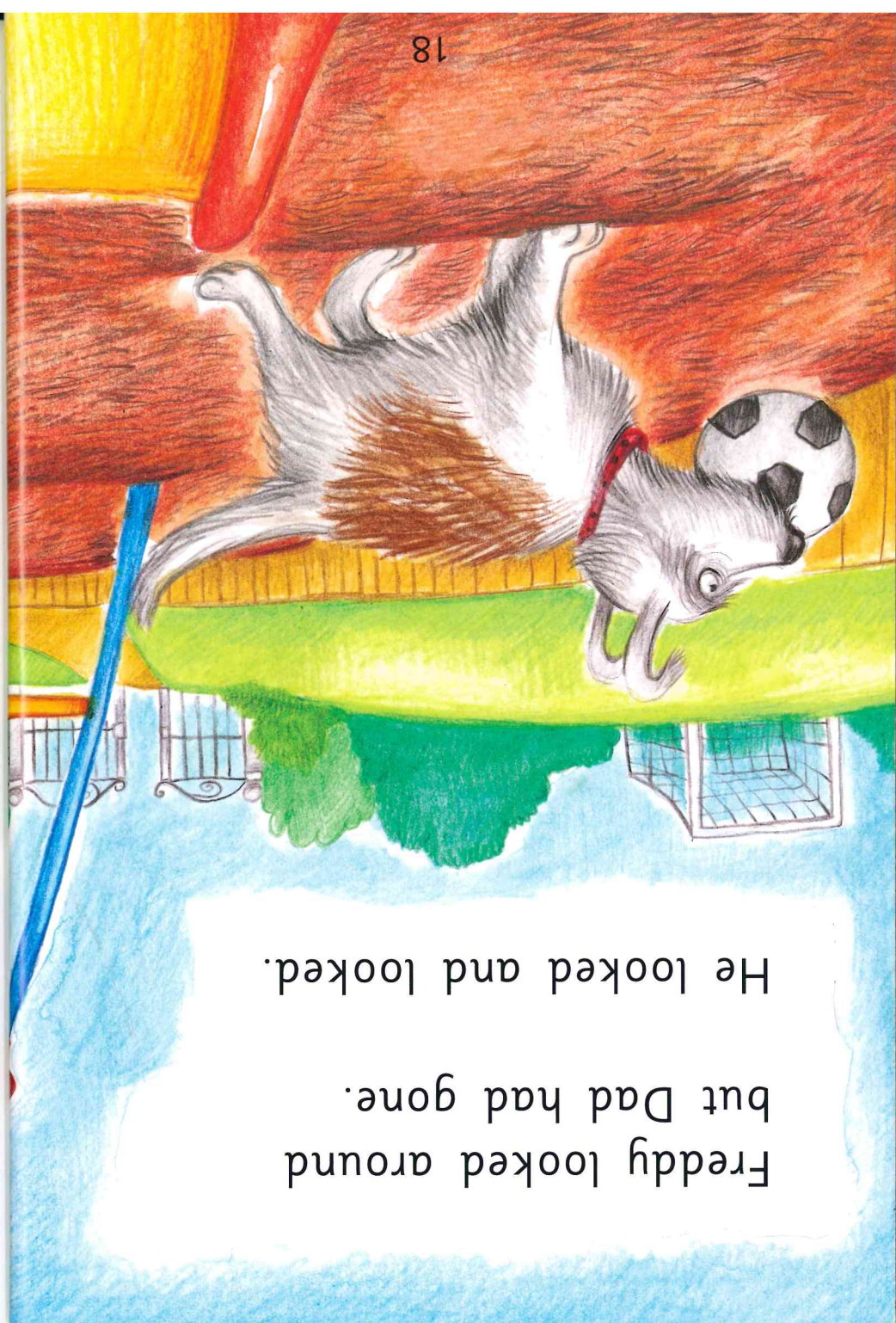
“OK,” said Dad, “Just one
