

USE OF THE SCHOOL GROUNDS POLICY

It has been decided by the Governing Bodies of Crosshall Junior School Academy Trust and Crosshall Infant School Academy Trust that there is a written policy banning the general use of the school grounds outside school hours without the written permission given by either the Headteacher or Assistant Headteachers of either school.

Appropriate signs have been placed at the four main entrances of the schools which must be observed at all times.

Parents and neighbours are encouraged to be vigilant and to call the Site Managers or the local Police should there be a concern.

Anyone seen on the grounds should be asked to leave quickly and without causing any damage.

No animals are allowed on site unless they are being used within the curriculum, or required for special needs purposes.

No cars should be driven onto the school grounds unless special permission has been granted.

Anyone refusing to leave the grounds is liable for prosecution and the Police will be summoned. Trespassers should be reminded of special legislation relating to school grounds.

The premises and associated land of the Crosshall Schools has been provided solely for the use of the children attending the schools.

Any item that could aid someone to climb onto the roof should be removed and stored elsewhere.

Smoking and vaping is not permitted anywhere on the school premises.
