


Titchy-witch

and she didn't like it. "Yuki!"




“Leave it alone,” said Cat-a-bogus.

and ready.”




But Titchy-witch couldn't wait

She and Dido tried to pull it out.


Titchy-witch wanted a spell to

...and Mum said, "What would the Fang Fairy say?"




“When a fang comes out,

She wanted hers this minute.


She decided to make a spell

As soon as Mum was out of the way, she borrowed a few magic ingredients.








Dido thought it might be too much!

 bring for all her fangs?




Titchy-witch started again:

and rolled round the kitchen floor.




Dido thought she looked
a bit scary.




Titchy-witch looked a bit funny
with no fangs.


But Titchy-witch wasn't too worried...

Titchy-witch was keeping very quiet too. The cat soon knew something was wrong.




Open wide
