**YEAR THREE: Children not attending a Burwell visit**

We are writing to inform you about the arrangements for children who will not be attending the upcoming Burwell residential trips. This information is only for children **not** attending **either** Burwell trip.

To ensure that all pupils still have an engaging and rewarding experience, we have planned an exciting in-school alternative programme. Throughout the three days, pupils will take part in a range of activities designed to mirror, as closely as possible, those taking place on the trip. These activities aim to provide opportunities for enjoyment, teamwork, and the development of new skills.

Due to the nature of several planned activities, we kindly ask that children come to school in their PE kit on all three days. Physical activities will be spread across the programme, so wearing appropriate clothing each day will help them participate fully and comfortably.

**These activities will take place 18<sup>th</sup> – 20<sup>th</sup> May** for all children not attending either of the Burwell House trips. Children who are attending either trip should attend school as normal whilst not away on the residential. During the second trip, 8<sup>th</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> June, all pupils should attend school as normal.

If providing PE kit for all three days presents any difficulty, please do not hesitate to speak with your child's class teacher, who will be happy to support you.
