

CJS CLUBS

Welcome to our Spring Term 2026 CJS Clubs Booklet!

Attending a CJS club is character building, improves children's skill levels, can encourage children to leave their comfort zone, and helps everyone to make new friends.

Clubs also count towards Future Me badges.

This guide gives a brief synopsis of each club available this term.

If your child has Free School Meals then, space permitting, the cost of all school run clubs will be waived.

We aim to ensure that each child participates in at least one club per term.

Places for clubs are available from the start of each term (Autumn, Spring, Summer) unless stated otherwise.

Clubs do not run during PCLR Week (wc 9th February 2026) unless stated otherwise under Club Detail (i.e. Hockey Club)

NEW PROCESS from this term	<p>Apply for clubs via the MCAS app from Wednesday 7th January at 6pm.</p> <p>On the MCAS app > under Clubs, all clubs that your child is able to apply for will appear on the MCAS app.</p> <p>You must give consent & make payment (where applicable) in the app before your child can take part in a club.</p> <p>If there are no places available, you can add your child to the waitlist.</p>
COST	<p>All lunchtime clubs are free of charge (unless stated otherwise).</p> <p>Morning and After school clubs are charged at £5.00 per term.</p> <p>Pupils receiving Free School Meals, dependent on space, will have the fee for school-led clubs reduced to 50p.</p>

If all allocated places have
been taken, you will be
able to register your child
for each club's waitlist.

If/ when a place becomes
available you will be
notified.
