

CJS CLUBS

Welcome to our Summer Term 2026 CJS Clubs Booklet!

Attending a CJS club is character building, improves children's skill levels, can encourage children to leave their comfort zone, and helps everyone to make new friends.

Clubs also count towards Future Me badges.

This guide gives a brief synopsis of each club available this term.

If your child has Free School Meals then, space permitting, the cost of all school run clubs will be reduced to £1.

Places for clubs are available from the start of each term (Autumn, Spring, Summer) unless stated otherwise.

NEW PROCESS from this term	<p>Apply for clubs via the MCAS app from Tuesday 21st April at 6pm.</p> <p>On the MCAS app > under Clubs, all clubs that your child is able to apply for will appear on the MCAS app.</p> <p>You must give consent & make payment (where applicable) in the app before your child can take part in a club.</p> <p>If there are no places available, you can add your child to the waitlist.</p>
COST	<p>All lunchtime clubs are free of charge (unless stated otherwise).</p> <p>Morning and After school clubs are charged at £5.00 per term.</p> <p>Pupils receiving Free School Meals, dependent on space, will have the fee for school-led clubs reduced to £1.</p>

Children should attend club first and then go to lunch afterwards

AFTER SCHOOL

3:20pm until 4:15pm (unless noted differently)

For sports clubs, children should change and then attend club.

How to apply for CJS Clubs



STEP 1

Clubs will launch on Bromcom MCAS app

Check your MCAS App for clubs available for your child's year group

Activities > Clubs

STEP 2

Consent & Payment

Give parental consent for your child to attend club and make payment for club(s) (where applicable).

Children will only be allowed to take part in a club once consent & payment (where applicable) has been confirmed

STEP 3

Waitlist

If all allocated places have been taken, you will be able to register your child for each club's waitlist.

If/ when a place becomes available you will be notified.
