MESSAGE FROM OUR HEADTEACHERS - MR AINSCOW & MR MURPHY

Dear Parent/ Carer,

As we near the end of our first full week, the children are settling in well within their new classes and year groups.

The staff are starting to get to grips with the new system, but we would ask that you continue to be patient with us as we get back to our normal levels of efficiency. We have had a number of visitors this week and they have commented repeatedly on how hardworking and focused our children are in their learning. This comes, in part, from having clear expectations of our children at school, and is always easier when we have support from home.

Therefore, please may we take this opportunity to ask for your help in supporting the school with our uniform expectations – including jewellery and make up. We expect children to only be wearing one stud in the lobe of the ear and to be able to take them out for PE. If your child has newly pierced ears, they will need to request a form from their class teacher which informs us and confirms date they can be removed.

Hair that falls below the shoulder must be tied up and no make up should be worn. For PE, please provide plain short and T-shirts with no patterns, pictures or large logos. We do not allow football strips to be worn.

As a school, we encourage children to wear uniform to promote a sense of community, to promote equity and to support discipline and focus. It also reduces the cost for parents as our uniform can be sourced from a variety of cost-effective locations, including our 'New to You' sale after school every second Wednesday in a month. This will recommence from Wednesday 8th October, 3:20pm-3:40pm.


