### MESSAGE FROM OUR HEADTEACHERS - MR AINSCOW & MR MURPHY

Dear Parent/ Carer,

Last night, several Crosshall staff were privileged to attend the Longsands Open Evening. We did this to get a better understanding of the school where the majority of our children attend in secondary education.

As we visited different departments around the school, we spoke to many teachers and were impressed with their passion for learning and their knowledge of their subjects. This level of subject expertise is one of the differences between primary and secondary and it was evident, speaking to the teachers, how much our children will benefit from their teaching and knowledge.

Another impressive aspect is the quality of their equipment. From the PE equipment to the science labs, children are able to learn more deeply using the correct equipment to explore their subjects. We had a great time using Bunsen burners to test chemicals!

The creative arts were particularly wonderful to see last night. In the art department, we were blown away by the quality of what we saw. It was like being in a gallery seeing amazing photography, painting and drawing from every year group.

Of course, in any school, the most important element is how we develop children. We were lucky to see many former pupils of Crosshall (even some who are now teachers at Longsands!) and their confidence and self-belief was fantastic to see. Those we talked to mentioned how much they were enjoying subjects like English and geography – even though some of them missed Crosshall.

Those colleagues who visited Longsands came back with ideas about how we can improve our curriculum and provide even better support for the transition into secondary school and we shall be reaching out to our secondary colleagues to explore more opportunities for collaborative work.

Next week is our Parent's Evenings and teachers are looking forward to talking with you about how your child has settled into the new year. Whilst these appointments are, by necessity, time limited, please remember that you can organise a follow up meeting if needed.
