Dear Parent/ Carer,

This week, we had the first of many interesting and exciting school trips that we organise throughout the year for pupils to experience. Year Six visited Legoland to support their learning in Design and Technology.

Trips are an important part of school life as children learn so much from seeing their learning in action, having fun together, sharing experiences with their friends and by overcoming challenges. For example, yesterday, the Year Six children learned how changes of direction, speed and having a consistent design theme collectively create an exhilarating ride, all whilst making sure the ride is safe! In addition, many children also overcame worries and strengthened their resilience by going on rides that at first sight seemed scary.
