PE Arrangements – Start Date and Timetable (From Monday 23rd February)

Thank you for your support following our recent letter regarding changes to PE arrangements. We are now writing to confirm that these changes will begin from Monday 23rd February 2026, after the February half-term break.

As outlined previously, from this point each class will have their one indoor PE lesson per week and one outdoor PE lesson per week on different days.

Pupils will either arrive at school in their PE kit or change into PE kit during the school day depending on whether the PE session is in the morning or afternoon.

Please find below the **timetable for indoor and outdoor PE sessions** for each class:

Classes with morning PE

Pupils should come to school in their PE kit and bring their complete school uniform in a suitable bag. They will change back into school uniform after their lesson.

Classes with afternoon PE

Pupils should come to school in their school uniform and bring their complete PE kit in a suitable bag. They will change into PE kit for their lesson and leave school in their PE kit.

Throughout the school, males and females shall change separately. We will support children to develop independence and organisation with this new routine.

PE kit and bags

To support children in managing this routine, please ensure that:

- All PE kit items are clearly named.
- All school uniform items are clearly named.
- Pupils bring a suitable bag to transport uniform/PE kit as needed. This should be able to fit in their locker.

We appreciate that this is a change of routine for children and families, and staff will support pupils to ensure they feel confident and organised.
