Spy Dog book series – Safeguarding Concern

We have been made aware by the Cambridgeshire County Council Safeguarding Team about a potential issue with some copies of the Spy Dog, Spy Cat and Spy Pup books by Andrew Cope. A website link printed in certain editions has been taken over by a third party and now leads to an adult site.

You may have already seen a link to this story on the BBC News webpage.

What's being done:

- The publisher, Puffin, has stopped sales and is working to have the website removed.
- They recommend removing any page that shows a web address from copies of the book.

What is recommended:

- Check any Spy Dog, Spy Pup and Spy Cat books your child may have and take out the page with a website link.
- Use this as an opportunity to remind your child about safe internet use and the importance of telling a trusted adult if they ever see something that makes them uncomfortable.
- Keep enjoying reading together – it's a wonderful way to stay involved and connected with what your child is learning.

Thank you for your continued support in helping us keep children safe while enjoying their reading.
