### Welcome – School Year 2025/2026

Tomorrow, a new school year begins, and we are looking forward to welcoming children back to school after, what we hope, was a restful and relaxing summer break. Below are some details for the start of the new term.

### Start and End Times

The school day begins at 8:45am and ends at 3:20pm. Our soft start, to ease congestion around the school site, begins at 8:35am.

Year Three will be greeted at their classroom door by their class teacher from Wednesday to Friday this week.

On Wednesday, Year Four, Five and Six will be met by their class teachers in the playground. On Thursday and Friday, Year Four, Five and Six should enter via the Blue Door.

From Monday 8<sup>th</sup> September, all year groups should come straight into school via the Blue Door.

Children are **not allowed** to use the Adventure Playground before or after school for safety reasons. Football and other ball games **should not** be played on the school site before or after school either.

The Blue Door will close at 8:45am and the gates shut soon after. Parents are asked to vacate the site as soon as possible at the start and end of the day.

Latecomers must go to the office to be signed in.
