Dear Parent/Carer,

Year Three and Four: Geography and Science Walk – St Neots

As part of our geography topic on **local field work** and science module on **plants**, we shall be walking to areas in the local community. As part of this unit, we have already been learning about our local area, and this trip will allow us to make real life links to lessons.

On **Wednesday 4th March, Year Three** will be going on a walk to the Riverside Park to observe the local geography. To further enhance our topic, the walk will consist of going to an area of the town centre and then to Riverside Park to look at plants for our current science topic.

Then, on **Friday 6th March, Year Four** will be completing the same walk.

Your child should arrive at school for the usual time in the morning. We plan to leave for our trip at approximately 9:10am and we will be back at school in time to have lunch as normal.

Please ensure your child has a break time snack with them.

Children will need to wear full uniform as usual; we recommend that they wear comfortable trainers too.

As we will be outside all morning, the children need to come to school appropriately prepared for the weather: a warm, waterproof coat if it is raining, or wearing sunscreen and a hat if it is sunny.

Year Four, Friday 6th March, both classes will have their PE lesson in the afternoon and should bring their PE kit to school to change into.

If your child is asthmatic, please ensure their inhaler is in school as they will need to have it with them on this trip. All inhalers must be clearly labelled and in date. For children who keep medication at school, it is the responsibility of the parent/ carer to ensure it is labelled and in-date.
