**Year Four: Museum of Cambridge Trip – 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2026**

To enhance our local history topic about Cambridge, we are visiting The Museum of Cambridge, which is a wonderful local museum, housing many interesting artefacts and exhibits about the people and events that have had a significant impact on the city's development over the years. During the one-day workshop, the children will have an opportunity to develop their enquiry skills through investigation of some mystery artefacts from the museum's collection and develop their understanding of how historians use primary and secondary sources of information to build their knowledge of the past.
