Year Six: National Curriculum Swimming Standard

As part of the national curriculum, all children must be given the opportunity to learn to swim and reach the expected standards. At our school, we are committed to ensuring that all Year Six children who have not yet met the national curriculum requirement of swimming 25 metres receive additional support.

To help these children achieve this goal, we are offering top-up swimming lessons during the summer term. These lessons will take place at One Leisure, St Neots and will be conducted by qualified swimming instructors alongside our teachers and teaching assistants. Transportation to and from the pool will be provided by a local coach company.

There will be a small cost involved to cover transportation to the venue. Once we finalise the number of participants, we will contact you to kindly ask for a contribution if your child has been selected to take part.

To organise this effectively, we need to determine which children would benefit from these top-up sessions and require a completed form for every child in Year Six. We appreciate your honesty in completing the form linked below, as this program is specifically for those who cannot yet swim 25 metres, in accordance with government guidelines. This is not suitable for children who have already met this requirement. While the swimming instructors will assess and group the children accordingly, your responses will provide a helpful starting point for their instruction.
