Year Three: St Neots Museum Visit

This half term, the children in Year Three have been learning about some key events in the history of St Neots. As a fabulous finish to our topic, the children will be going to visit the St Neots Museum.

Dates of the trip by class:

3CHE	Tuesday 2 nd June
3Cho	Wednesday 3 rd June
3LR	Friday 5 th June

The trip will take place during the school day. Your child should arrive at school for the usual time. We aim to leave school at 9:00am and we will be back at school in time to have lunch as normal. Please ensure your child has a break time snack with them and water bottle. Please also make sure that children have sun cream on as we will be spending time outside. **Children will need to wear full uniform; preferably with a logo so they can be easily identified, and we recommend they wear comfortable trainers too.**

The visit will include a guided walk led by experts from the museum to four town centre locations that are key to the history and development of the town's geography. Then, the children will undertake an object handling session, sharing objects from the museum's collection that link with the walk and illustrate ideas of time, changes in technology and the development of communities. The visit will conclude with a chance for the pupils to explore the galleries. Visiting the museum, supports this term's learning about our local history and the fascinating stories of local people from the past.

The voluntary contribution cost for this trip is £4.75 per pupil. Please complete and return the attached reply slip to your child's class teacher **by Wednesday 20th May.**

If your child is asthmatic, please ensure their inhaler is in school as they will need to have it with them on this trip. All inhalers must be clearly labelled and in-date. For children, who keep medication at school, it is the responsibility of the parent/carer to ensure it is labelled and in-date.
