## Year 6 Transition to Year 7

We are looking forward to welcoming your child to Ely College in September. We know the move to secondary school can be accompanied by worry and enthusiasm for both parents and children. We recognise that your family may need additional reassurance about the process. College staff are working closely with staff in the primary schools to ensure information is shared and that children recognise some staff before they come for their induction day.

### House Allocation

It is with great excitement and pleasure than I can inform you that your child will be in Franklin House. The allocation of Houses is completed by our data team using all the information we have about a child. Siblings have been allocated to the same House and then we look to achieve an even distribution of academic ability, additional needs, sporting ability etc. The House the child is in has no impact on their teaching groups or who they can socialise with during their break and lunch times.

Franklin House is named after Rosalind Franklin, a chemist and x-ray crystallographer whose work was central to the understanding of the molecular structures of DNA, RNA and graphite. Although her works on coal and viruses were appreciated in her lifetime, her contributions to the discovery of the structure of DNA were largely only recognised after her death in 1958. For example, some may have a geography lesson while others undertake a history lesson. The group your children is in will not be the class they will join in September.

Please send your child into college with a packed lunch and a refillable water bottle. If your child normally receives a free school lunch, we will provide a packed lunch for them.

The cost of lessons varies slightly between Visiting Music Teachers (VMT), depending on whether they work on behalf of Cambridge Music Service or are independent/private tutors. Below are the approximate costs of instrumental lessons:

- 20 minutes per week – between £11 and £13
- 30 minutes per week – between £17 to £19

Each term consists of 10 individual peripatetic music lessons, with the allocated VMT. Lessons will be commencing w/b 8<sup>th</sup> September 2025.
