Trip To Bletchley on Friday 7 November

We have organised a school visit to Bletchley Park on Friday 7 November during the school day.

The trip will include a guide tour and a learning session on Past, present and future encryption led by staff from Bletchley Park. The aim of the visit is for students to deepen their understanding of computing and its impacts on society and the world. The tour and lesson are both directly relevant to GCSE Computer Science.

We will travel by minibus leaving the school at 9:00am and return to school in time for the school buses at 3:05pm. Students should wear their school uniform and will need to bring a packed lunch and drink with them (lunches will be available for those eligible for free school meals).

The cost of the trip is £23.00 per student, which includes the tickets for Bletchley Park, along with travel to and from the venue, and will be payable by 31 October 2025.
