Blood Brothers – Wellingborough Castle Theatre

Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of the continued development of Performing Arts at Lincroft, we are pleased to inform you of a theatre visit to Wellingborough Castle Theatre on Tuesday 24 March 2026, to see the latest touring production of Willy Russell's Blood Brothers.

This visit is planned specifically for GCSE Drama students and directly supports their studies. Experiencing professional live theatre is a required element of the AQA GCSE Drama specification, and this performance will provide valuable material for the Live Theatre evaluation element of the course.

Blood Brothers was originally written as a stage play in 1981 and later adapted into a musical, premiering at the Liverpool Playhouse in 1983. It has since been performed worldwide and is regarded as one of the most significant works of modern British theatre.

Students will be transported to and from the theatre by school minibus, departing from Lincroft at 6:00pm, allowing sufficient time to arrive before the 7:30pm performance. Once the performance has finished, students will be transported back to Lincroft Academy via minibus to be collected by parents/carers.

The cost of the trip is £21.50, which includes theatre tickets and return transport. If your child would like to attend, please make payment via MCAS by no later than Sunday 1 March 2026.
