I am delighted to be able to offer your child the opportunity to hear the world-famous City of Birmingham Symphony Orchestra (CBSO) perform highlights from Classic FM's Hall of Fame on Thursday 30 April at Symphony Hall, in Birmingham.

Featuring much-loved pieces including 'Jupiter' from Holst's The Planets, the Jurassic Park theme and Elgar's 'Nimrod' from his Enigma Variations, this should be a fantastic concert.

There is nothing as exciting as hearing and watching musicians in an orchestra playing live and this programme promises to be superb. Whilst it is not a pre-requisite for taking GCSE Music to attend a concert, I have been on the look-out for another suitable concert for some time; featuring a wide contrast of musical styles I hope there will be something for everyone to enjoy, especially those students who have not accessed a live orchestral performance before.
