GCSE BrightSparks Concert - Thursday 6 November

I am delighted to be able to offer your child the opportunity to attend the London Philharmonic Orchestra's GCSE BrightSparks Concert on **Thursday 6 November** at the Royal Festival Hall in London. This concert is specifically designed for GCSE Music students; with detailed musical analysis of pieces performed, key terminology is displayed on screen with excerpts pulled apart to enhance understanding. The concert will explore a wide range of music from the Baroque period to the 21st century and will also cover concerto and film music, which are two big Areas of Study for GCSE Music.
