We will be traveling to the university via minibus during period 1. As we will be back by lunchtime, students must be prepared for afternoon lessons and are therefore required to wear school uniform.

There is no obligation to contribute, and no pupil will be omitted from the visit because they do not pay or do not pay in full. However, the visit cannot go ahead if the school does not receive sufficient parental contributions. Financial assistance may be possible for those in receipt of Pupil Premium funding, please contact me directly to discuss further. Subsidies are provided on a case-by-case basis
