Trust Carbon Zero Event

I am delighted to inform you that your child has signed up to join our new school Eco-Council. As part of this, they have the opportunity to take part in our Meridian Environment Day, which will take place on Friday 5 June (World Environment Day).

This is a Trust-wide event involving students from all 14 Meridian secondary schools. The day will be hosted at Weldon Village Academy, where students will work together to explore climate change, celebrate environmental action, and develop ideas for projects they can lead in their own schools.

Throughout the day, students will take part in a range of engaging activities, including:

- A climate action workshop delivered by an external organisation (Another Way)
- A practical sustainable site audit, which students will be able to replicate back at school
- Collaborative activities with students from across the Trust

The aim of the day is to equip students with the knowledge, confidence and tools to lead a climate-focused project within our school during the next academic year.

Travel arrangements:

Students will travel to Weldon Village Academy by minibus.

- Departure from Lincroft Academy: 08:30
- Arrival at Weldon: 09:30
- Departure from Weldon: 14:30
- Return back to school: 15:30

We will be returning to school after the busses have left. If students require collection as a result, please make arrangements for this. If students usually make their own way home, they will be dismissed as soon as we return to school.

Students will be accompanied by Mrs Buckley-Theed, who leads our school's Eco-Council. All associated costs for this trip are to be covered by Meridian Trust, so there is no charge to students.
