Visit to Milton Ernest Hall Care Home - Monday 24 November 2025

Dear Parent/Carer

We will be running a trip to visit Milton Ernest Hall Care Home on Monday 24 November 2025 for Year 9 Health and Social Care students. The aim of this visit is for students to entertain and engage with elderly residents and staff. Interacting with residents allows our students to learn from their life experiences, knowledge, and resilience. They will learn communication skills, teamwork, and adaptability while working with diverse residents.

Students are required to wear a full school uniform as we aim to leave Lincroft Academy at 10:55 and be back by lunchtime. Students must be prepared to attend afternoon lessons.

As this visit takes place mainly in school time, it is necessary to ask for a voluntary contribution of £1 per student and can be made via MCAS, which covers transport costs and insurance. There is no obligation to contribute, and no pupil will be omitted from the visit because they do not pay or do not pay in full. However, the visit cannot go ahead if the school does not receive sufficient parental contributions. Financial assistance may be possible for those in receipt of Pupil Premium funding, please contact me directly to discuss further. Subsidies are provided on a case-by-case basis.

Consent form must be given on MCAS by no later than midday Friday 21 November. Please check your emergency contact details, and student's medical details are correct on MCAS.
