Information from our safeguarding team

It is always important to remind students about online safety, especially with the everchanging platforms and apps they use to communicate. While WhatsApp groups can be a helpful way to stay connected with friends, they also carry risks—especially large groups where not everyone may be known personally. Children can be exposed to inappropriate content, misinformation, or even messages from strangers. For this reason, the school does not recommend students being part of large groups. Encourage your child to think carefully before posting, never share personal details, and leave any group that makes them feel uncomfortable or unsafe. We also encourage regular conversations about online activity and keeping communication open so children feel comfortable sharing concerns. Setting boundaries around group participation, reviewing who they are in groups with, and reminding them that online messages can have lasting consequences, are all important steps.
