Message from our Safeguarding Team: Digital Wellbeing – "Addictive by Design"

In last week's <u>Principal's Message</u>, we shared reminders about our policy on mobile phones and what that means for students. This week, we're sharing a leaflet titled "Addictive by Design," which explores how social media and digital platforms are intentionally created to keep users engaged, often for far longer than intended.

The leaflet highlights the effects of excessive screen time on young people's focus, academic performance, and mental health, and offers useful strategies for families to encourage more balanced online habits. We encourage all parents and carers to take a few minutes to read the leaflet and discuss key messages with your child. Small changes can make a big difference in helping young people develop healthy, mindful relationships with technology. Thank you for continuing to support our expectations that phones must not be seen or heard around the Academy.

Safe car travel to school

With the arrival of the cold weather, there can be more parents/carers using cars to bring children to and from school. We always encourage students to walk, where possible, even just part of the way and they are picked up further from the Academy.
