Lincroft Academy – Sports Day 2026

We are delighted to announce that Lincroft Academy will be hosting our Sports Day on **Wednesday 15 July**. Students should arrive at school as normal and will be dismissed at the usual time.

This exciting occasion aims to encourage teamwork, collaboration, and enjoyment among our students as they participate in various inter-house sporting events and a House athletics competition. There will be a range of competitive and non-competitive activities suitable for all skill levels, enabling all students to embrace the community spirit and enjoy taking part in sport together.

As an alternative to their PE polo shirt, students are permitted to wear a suitable T-shirt displaying their House colours, although there is no expectation to purchase one specifically for the event. If students do not wish to wear their House colours, their PE polo shirt should be worn as usual. T-shirts should be worn with PE shorts or skirt and trainers, in line with our uniform [policy](#). Please be reminded that sliders, Crocs, sandals, or similar footwear are not permitted.

Additionally, all students should bring a hat, sunscreen, and a bottle of water. Students who require medication, such as asthma inhalers, should ensure they bring these with them on the day.

Students are responsible for any personal belongings they bring and should avoid bringing unnecessary valuables. Our usual mobile phone policy will apply throughout the day; mobile phones must remain switched off and stored in bags.

This year, students will enjoy their lunch at the New Field, rather than returning to the main school site. Caterlink, our catering provider, will offer an adapted menu from which students may purchase lunch. We will send out a pre-order form nearer the time. Alternatively, students may bring in their own packed lunch.

At the end of the day, students will return to school for dismissal. Please note the New Field car park will remain closed to parents and carers collecting their children until all students have been safely escorted back to the school site.

Unfortunately, we are unable to accommodate parents and carers as spectators on this occasion. However, please be assured that students will be enthusiastically supported by staff and their peers throughout the day.

Should Sports Day be cancelled due to adverse weather or extreme heat, students will follow their normal timetable. Our reserve Sports Day is scheduled for Thursday 16 July.
