Y11 & Y10 Art Trip to Tate Britain and Tate Modern

Dear Parent/Carer

The Art Department would like to invite your child to visit Tate Britain and Tate Modern in London on Monday 2 February 2026.

Year 11 Art students have just started Component 2 (Externally Set Assignment) of their GCSE course, which is worth 40% of their overall grade.

Year 10 Art students are currently working on Component 1 (Portfolio) of their GCSE course, which is worth 60% of their overall grade.

To support with the creation and development of ideas and any additional artists for their final outcomes, students will explore the Art objects and collections of Tate Britain and the Tate Modern, gathering information and taking photos to inspire ideas for their projects.

We will be travelling to London by coach, leaving from Lincroft Academy at 9.00am and aim to arrive back to Lincroft by 8.30pm, depending on traffic. We will contact parents and carers if there is a delay.

Students are required to come to school in full school uniform but can wear trainers if preferred.

They will be required to bring a packed lunch for the day, and a snack for the journey. If your child is in receipt of free school meals, a packed lunch will be provided for them. There will also be opportunities to buy drinks and snacks from the cafés and gift shops, students may therefore wish to bring a small amount of money with them on the trip.

The cost of the trip is £25. Payments will need to be made via MCAS by no later than Thursday 29th January 2026.
