## Year 11 Summer 2026 Exam Series

This week marks the start of the Summer 2026 written examinations, so we wanted to inform you of the support we are providing for your child during their final weeks at Lincroft Academy, as well as address some common queries. This morning students had an assembly where they received a printed copy of the changes to their regular schedule and given key reminders about exam regulations.

### Key Dates and Events:

- First written exam of summer series: Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> May
- Exam leave begins: Friday 5<sup>th</sup> June
- Leavers' Day: Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> June
- Exam results day: Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> August

### Frequently Asked Questions:

#### How will my child know which exam is coming up and which seat to sit in?

Students have been given a hard copy of their exam statement of entry; however, they should check Bromcom every evening or morning for last minute changes. These will also be displayed on the exams noticeboard as they arrive at school. In very rare occasions, e.g. sickness, the seating plan may have a last-minute change. It is important for parents to know if an exam finishes after the normal end of the school day, so that alternative transport arrangements can be made. Year 11 are still welcome to use the school buses throughout the exam period.

#### Exams start on the 7<sup>th</sup> May. What will my child be doing in lessons?

Re-teaching of content, revision & exam paper practice will continue until the last exam in that subject. When exams are completed for a subject, students are expected to bring their Independent Study Packs with them, and they will be supported by staff to revise for upcoming exams.

#### What do revision sessions look like?

Students are invited to arrive to school at 8am on the day of a morning exam, if they wish. Breakfast snacks will be provided, and they will be able to complete their independent revision with the help of subject teachers in the dining room. Students will sometimes

have a revision session during period 3 for afternoon exams, in addition to planned lessons and after school support.

**When is my child no longer required to be in school ?**

Students are expected in school full time up until and including Friday 5<sup>th</sup> June. From Monday 8<sup>th</sup> June students must attend all exams and may attend the masterclass sessions indicated on the adjusted timetable attached. We strongly encourage students to attend as many masterclass sessions as possible

**What if my child wants to remain in school during the day from the 8<sup>th</sup> June?**

Students are welcome in school, and this is encouraged. When they are not in an exam, for safeguarding purposes students must be in the ILC room where they will have access to computers and a member of staff to support them.

**What if my child wants to leave school after an exam, from the 9<sup>th</sup> June?**

Students who wish to leave site must sign out at the Sports Hall reception at the end of their exam. If students are leaving after a lesson, they must sign out at main reception.

**What should my child wear during the exam period ?**

Students are required to be in full school uniform throughout the exam period. During warmer temperatures, we will of course make on the day adjustments where necessary, so that students remain comfortable.

**What are the plans for Year 11 on the 1<sup>st</sup> June?**

On the 1<sup>st</sup> June, the academy is closed for Year 7-10 students, however is still open for Year 11 students. Students will be mostly following their normal timetable on this day, and more information will be shared nearer the time.

**What are the arrangements for break and lunchtime?**

The arrangements for break and lunch remain unchanged, they were practised during the mock exams so that students know what to expect.

**What should we do with the resources and uniform my child would like to donate?**

There will be some named boxes for each house outside of the last Science exam on 15<sup>th</sup> June and at the Leavers' day assembly. We would welcome any unwanted freshly laundered uniform, school shoes, calculators, course guides and revision books that have not been written in. These will be recycled and used for families in need of support or in our pre-loved shop.

We will continue to CARE and support every student through this important time. If you have any further questions, please do not hesitate to contact the school through your child's house team.
