Year 11 Update

We are very proud of Year 11 for their mature and determined approach to their exams so far; they have been impressive and we are sure that this will lead to success on results day. We met with students yesterday morning to remind them of some essential information for the days ahead, which you can find below.

Friday 5th June

On Friday 5th June, all Year 11 students have an English Language exam at 9am. Students will be able to leave school when they finish this exam, if you permit them to do so. Students sitting the Music exam in the afternoon session will remain in school for a masterclass before the exam. Any other students who wish to remain in school will have supervised independent study.

If you want your child to **remain on school site** until the end of the day, please complete the forms link - [Friday 5th June – Fill out form](#) by 9am on Friday. If this form is not completed, your child will be permitted to leave site after the exam.

Monday 8th June

From Monday 8th June, students begin exam leave and are no longer required to attend school other than for their exams. From this date, students will be able to come into school for supervised independent study, if they wish to do so. We will continue to run exam masterclasses which students are encouraged to attend prior to their afternoon exams. The timetable for this can be found [here](#).

Students need to arrive for the normal time of 8:35am and attend tutor time for a celebration with their group. They will leave site when the event ends at 1:00pm. The detailed plan for the day will be shared next week. Please ensure your child has plans for getting home after the event.
