- 2. **Be ambitious** by trying new experiences, stepping outside their comfort zones, and discovering new talents, interests, and aspirations.
- 3. Be resilient by taking on challenges, developing new skills, and learning to persevere when things feel unfamiliar or difficult.
- 4. **Use the skills learnt in enrichment both inside and outside of the classroom**, connecting these to real-world contexts, teamwork, creativity, and functional life skills that are essential for adulthood.
- 5. **Understand the importance of the skills they develop in enrichment**—such as communication, collaboration, leadership, and problem-solving—and how these are vital for success in future education, employment, and everyday life.
- 6. **Explore the relevance of enrichment skills in future pathways and careers**, with regular opportunities to understand how their activities link to a variety of roles across industries and sectors.
- 7. Access a wide and diverse programme of enrichment opportunities, with students selecting two activities each half term from a varied offer including:

  - o Leadership and Enterprise: School Improvement, School Newsletter, Enterprise Challenge, 99 Things and PLEDGES, Taskmaster
