What are SEND Hubs?

Peterborough has a network of Special Educational Needs and Disabilities Hubs, known as SEND Hubs. Each Hub is commissioned by Peterborough City Council and is hosted by a Peterborough education setting. There are SEND Hubs in both primary and secondary schools across Peterborough.

Each Hub has a specific SEND focus area:

- Autism
- Deafness
- Physical Disability
- Social, Emotional and Mental Health
- Speech, Language and Social Communication

There are a limited number of places in the Hubs for children and young people to be directly supported by the school and Hub. These places are allocated by the SEND Panel as part of the Education, Health and Care (EHC) specialist placement process.
