
Audition Backing Tracks and Scores

1. Knowledge Test Revision and tests

Students will be given knowledge tests once a term to consolidate their theory and key terminology knowledge. These will be on Teams and the revision will be available through Quizlet. All links and instructions will be on Teams.

Students will be expected to use this to consolidate content covered during lessons and to revise for their end of unit assessment.

2. Learning Lines

Students will have a practical assessment once every half term, usually their last lesson of that half term. In order to help prepare for this, often students will be given scripts to learn or lines to write and learn themselves. There may be occasion when this is not set however, and this will be due to the students being asked to perform devised pieces in groups in which case students would create and rehearse their lines in class.
