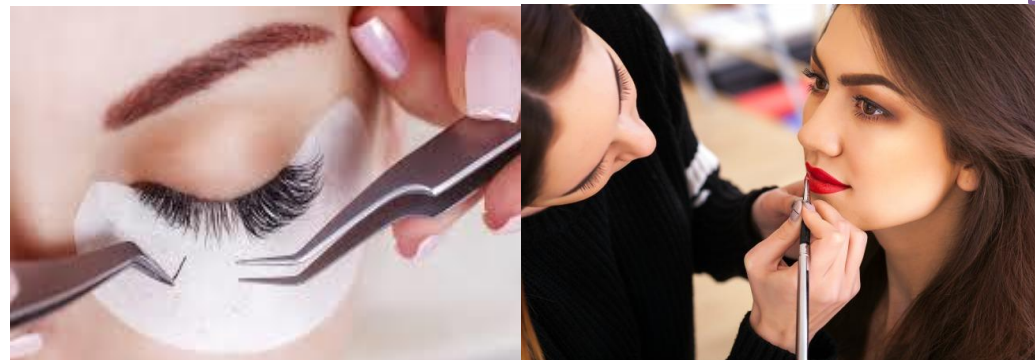
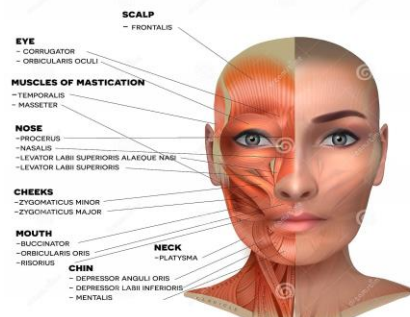

HOW TO SUPPORT YOUR CHILD AT HOME

KEY STAGE 5 HAIR AND BEAUTY

Encourage your child to be well organised and prepared for every lesson.

Students will be required to stay one late night per week, this is a Wednesday evening, this is an essential part of the course to develop the student's skills and confidence in preparation for practical grading unit exams and the synoptic practical exam.

This is also realistic to a salon environment as it is a commercial salon session where students work on real clients developing commercial timings, confidence and communication skills.



KEY AREAS OF SUPPORT

- ▶ Professional appearance (tunic and black trousers and flat black shoes)
- ▶ Ensure your child brings their kits in for every practical lesson
- ▶ Organised folder for theory work and handouts that support your child for exams
- ▶ Support and encourage your child to meet deadlines
- ▶ Encourage your child to practice practical skills at home
- ▶ Assist your child in finding appropriate clients for their assessments
- ▶ Support your child to recall theory knowledge and revise for written exams
