Below is an outline of the KS5 Sociology learning journey at Nene Park Academy:

- Year 12 topics: Education, Families & Households and Research methods.
- Year 13 topics: Crime and deviance, Beliefs in society and theory and methods



HOMEWORK: Students will be set 2 pieces of homework each week by both teachers.
All homework is set on Teams. This could be:

- **Retrieval practice quizzes set on Microsoft Teams/Seneca** - Students are set multiple-choice quizzes on Teams to go over content covered during lessons. Sometimes this will be content covered at the time and sometimes it will be content covered during previous topics.
- **Extended reading** - Extended reading plays a key role in extending the knowledge, understanding and skills that are developed in school and provides opportunities for students to consolidate, enrich and extend their learning.
- **Exam practice** - to allow students to become familiar with exam style questions and revise structures for longer answer questions.
