Dear Parents/Carers,

The temperature has certainly dropped, and it is beginning to feel a lot more like Winter, with Christmas only around the corner. With this in mind, we would like to invite you to our EYFS Christmas Celebration performances on Monday 15th December at 2pm and Tuesday 16th December at 4pm in our school Hall. On the Tuesday, we will keep the children after school and help them change into their costumes ready to perform at 4pm, therefore you will not need to collect them at the usual time of 3.15pm. We will be singing some of the songs from the 'Nursery Rhyme Nativity' and the children will be dressing as some of the well-known characters from the first Christmas story. We ask for your support in enabling us to ensure that the children are prepared for these performances, and you will therefore shortly receive a letter explaining what they will need to wear. Rest assured; we provide majority of the main costume for each child but ask for your support with some plain clothes that they will wear underneath.

Due to pupil numbers, we can only offer each family a maximum of two tickets across both performances. Please register your interest with the office team stating whether you would like two tickets for the Monday, or two tickets for the Tuesday, or one ticket for each performance. The office staff will allocate tickets accordingly. Please remember to bring your tickets with you to the performance (all audience members will need a ticket for the performance to avoid being turned away). If you are able to arrange childcare for siblings (older and younger) we would greatly appreciate this to ensure that there are minimal distractions for the children.

The performance is expected to last approximately 30 minutes. We will need to allow time for the children to change back into their school uniform afterwards. In order to safeguard all children, please wait in the Hall after the performance; we will take the children back to the classroom and support them in getting changed. You will then be escorted round to the classroom doors to collect your child once they have changed and are ready. If you are not part of the audience, please aim to collect your child from school from 5pm (on the Tuesday, usual end of school day on the Monday), as soon as they are ready, we will bring them to you at the classroom door.

If your child has been absent from school with illness on the day of the performance, they will not be able to return later to participate in the performance. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to speak to a member of the team or request a meeting via the office. We are looking forward to getting into the Christmas spirit with you all.
