Dear Parents/Carers,

We are pleased to invite you to this year's KS1 'Songs Around the Christmas Tree'

There will be two concerts one on Wednesday 10th December at 2.00pm and one on Thursday 11th December at 4.00pm. Due to pupil numbers, we can only offer each family a maximum of **two tickets** over both performances and these tickets will be allocated on a 'first come, first served' basis. If you would like more tickets we will hold a reserve list and you can request up to two additional tickets. These extra tickets will be allocated after the initial allocation has taken place, which will be **Friday 28th November** (all requests need to be returned by this date).

To request tickets, please e-mail the school office.

Please remember to bring your tickets with you on the night! (All audience members, including children of any age, will need a ticket for the performances to avoid being turned away). Pre-school age children/younger siblings are welcome as part of the audience for our afternoon performance, but we ask that they do not attend the 4.00pm performance wherever possible.

Children will not require a costume for the concert, but could we please request that they bring a Christmas jumper to school on Wednesday (Thursday is National Christmas Jumper Day).

The performance is expected to last approximately 30 minutes and on Thursday 11th December children will remain in school at 3.15pm to get changed into their jumpers ready for 4.00pm. Pupils will be offered a light snack at this time.

If your child has been absent from school with illness on the day of the performance, they will not be able return in the evening to participate in the performance, otherwise please ensure **all** children attend each performance.
