Our Uniform

Nene Valley is keen to promote a smart image with our uniform and create a sense of belonging to the school community. It is Governing Body policy for children to wear school uniform and by choosing Nene Valley Primary School for your child, you are agreeing to abide by this policy.

Winter Wear

- Knitted hat with logo (optional)
- White Polo shirts (preferably with logo)

- Sky blue t-shirt (must have logo)

Alternatively, you can visit the store at 9 Botolph Bridge Trading Estate. Please see below items available from Total Clothing that are preferred at school. Items without logos can also be purchased at other retail outlets, providing they are in keeping with the school colours (Navy/grey).

We ask you to clearly label **all** your child's uniform (**including each of their shoes!**) as well as water bottles and bags. **You do not need to purchase a book bag; these will be provided for you by the school.**

Drawstring bag for spare clothes – this needs to be clearly identifiable for your child with a **SMALL** keyring and their name.

School Book bag – please note rucksacks are **not** suitable. We ask you to attach a **small** keyring that your child can recognise to help them identify their own book bag and support them to develop their independence. This key ring should be **small and easily identifiable** – no toys please.

Jewellery

One pair of stud earrings can be worn (hooped, hanging or creole earrings are not permitted). **No other jewellery should be worn at school.**

You will need:

Spare clothes - in a **clearly labelled Nene Valley Primary drawstring bag** to always stay in school (They do not need to be a school uniform, but plain, school colours please)

- Underwear – especially several pairs of spare socks and pants
- Jogging bottoms/leggings
- T-shirt
- Jumper

Wellington boots - these **must** be clearly named and will be **kept in school**; we play outdoors in **ALL** weathers!

Plain black plimsolls (Indoor shoes) – These will be left at school. Children will change into these shoes when they arrive to school and wear them when learning inside. They will change into their school shoes for playing outside. School will provide the first pair of these. We will be asking you to give us your child's shoe size.





Named Lunch box (If having a packed lunch) School meals are available free of charge to all children in Reception and Key Stage One.

Drinks and snack

Milk is available in school and is free for all children under the age of 5; once the children turn 5 there is a small charge. This must be ordered online by parents at www.coolmilk.com regardless of your child's age. We ask that you send your child to school with a transparent, school water bottle that has been filled every day. Water bottles can be purchased from the school office; we ask you to pay using ParentPay and your child will receive their water bottle with their name clearly marked on in class. It is often helpful if they have a sticker on it that they recognise, particularly whilst they are in the early stages of learning how to recognise their name.

You do not need to send a snack to school with your child, this is provided for them at school.
