Vulnerable Groups Bursary

Academic Year	2026 – 2027
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This is the application for the Bursary Fund for defined vulnerable groups.

The Bursary Fund for defined vulnerable groups is available for you if, you are aged 16 or over, and under 19 on 1 September 2026 and:

- are in or recently left local authority care
- receive Income Support **or** Universal Credit in your own name
- receive Disability Living Allowance (DLA) in your own name **and** either Employment and Support Allowance (ESA) **or** Universal Credit.
- receive Personal Independence Payment (PIP) in your name **and** either ESA **or** Universal Credit

Applications can only be considered once you have been able to provide evidence that you meet one of the above criteria.

Evidence can be provided at the same time as you submit your application form, or it can be sent to the sixth form separately. Examples of acceptable evidence include documents confirming that you receive the relevant benefits in your own name, or confirmation that you are in or have recently left local authority care. How to make an application

Please complete this application form either on paper or by completing the online version of the form and submitting it by email and returning it to Julie Bishop, Post 16 Support Officer @ Sixthfor,@northstowe.education. They can also answer any questions you might have about the bursary.

Please submit your application and the necessary evidence of your eligibility by the deadline.

Deadline for applications 30th September 2026

Further applications can be made during the academic year, though please note that available funds may be limited.

How we can support you and how we will provide support

In most cases, financial support is provided in the form of materials, books, equipment and catering account credit. Where monetary payments are made directly to students, these will be as reimbursements and will be made by BACS transfer, to a bank account held in your name. In such cases, bank details can be provided as part of the application or will be requested once a bursary has been awarded.

The 16-19 Bursary Fund is to help you with your education related costs.	
Transport costs	Where possible, the sixth form team will provide weekly / termly tickets. In other cases, bus and train travel will be reimbursed monthly on production of tickets or travelcard / mobile app statements. Car / motorcycle use will be reimbursed at £0.45 per mile monthly from your home address. Transport cost reimbursements will be adjusted to reflect attendance in the month prior to payment.
Course books	Course textbook(s) and revision guide(s) as selected by the course teaching staff, for each course that you study.
Stationery pack	A pack of stationery including folders, lined paper and pens etc. replenished termly, with the option of a calculator if required.
Equipment	Where you require your own equipment or tools for your course, e.g. a graphical calculator, art materials or equipment for practical work. We can also provide a loaned laptop, for the duration of your course.
Specialist clothing	Any specialist clothing required for your courses, such as safety boots or items branded with the sixth form's name or logo.
Meal costs	Account credit to use at on-site catering facilities to a total of £3.00 per day (including topping-up free meal allowances to £3.00)
Trips and visits	Essential field trips to achieve or support study programme goals or course objectives, e.g. Geography field trip, DofE Award expeditions.
UCAS application	Reimburse application fees for your UCAS application in Year 13.
Incidental travel	Partial or full reimbursement of the costs of attending industry / work placements, university interviews or open days, as funds permit.
Entry tests e.g. UCAT	Reimburse fees for university or other HE admissions tests in Year 13.
