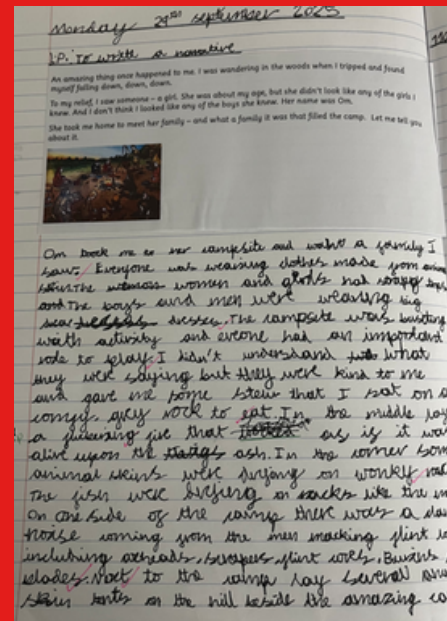
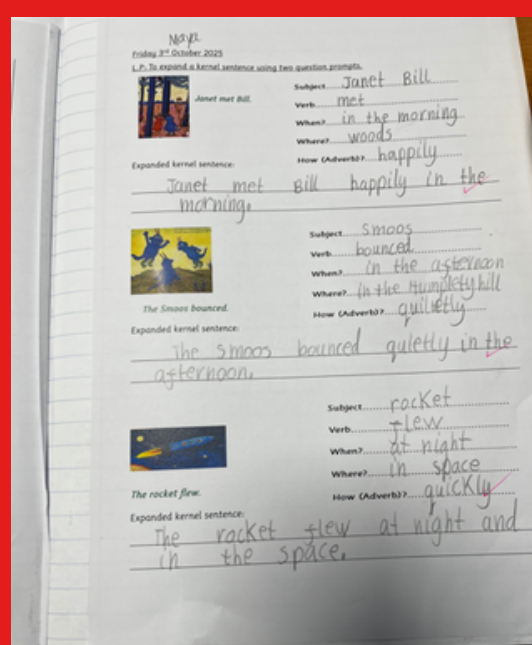
Key Stage Two
