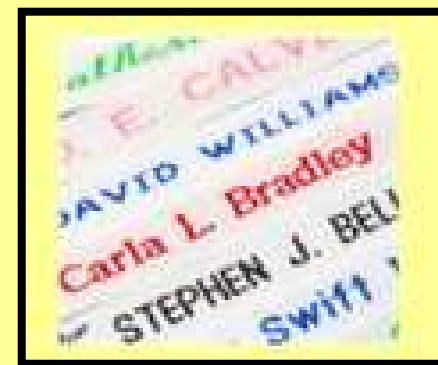

- Encourage good tidying up



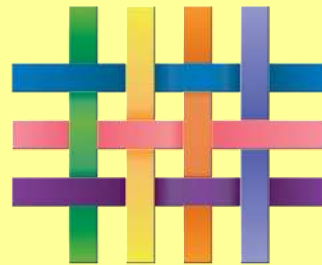
