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Daily Routines

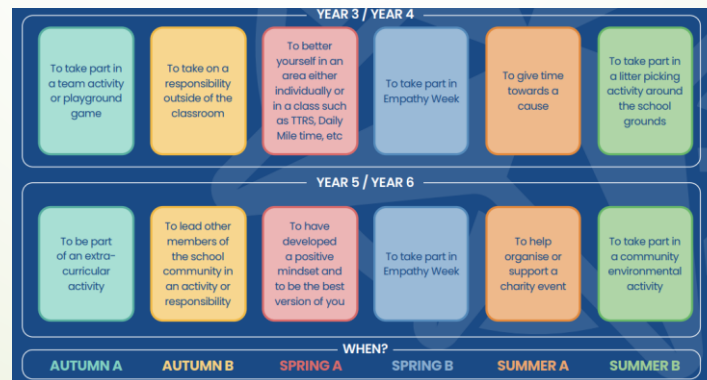
- Registration/Start of day (from 8:35 – 8:45am)

Behaviour Expectations

Learning Logs

- Front section – helpful pages for the children, used regularly in class and can be used at home to help with homework. These include, times tables and division facts, shape facts, 100 number grid, national curriculum spelling list. To have in school every day.
- Second section – Reading record to record when children read at home which will be rewarded with house points.
- Aim for a minimum of 3 reads a week.
- Signed weekly by both parent/carer and teacher.

Homework

- Homework will be sent home on a Wednesday and back to school the following Monday.
- We aim to send home English (reading), spellings and Maths activities most weeks.
- If children if need any pointers, please encourage them to talk to their teacher who will always be willing to support your child.

Reading

- 3 Reading sessions in school a week.
- Focussing on the 8 key strategies in order to become fluent, confident readers.
- Predicting, Asking Questions, Clarifying, Summarising, Visualising, Inferring, Making connections and Evaluating.
- Reading books sent home, please continue to listen to/share these books with your child and sign off their home reading in their learning logs.
- Non-fiction library where children can also borrow books.

TT Rockstars

- Login sheet.
- Practise set times tables weekly.
- Earn certificates and become a 'rockstar'.
- Children will be required to complete a government times table test in year 4, so it's always good to be prepared early!
