

16 – 19 Bursary ~ What Can I Claim For?

Essential Study Materials

Stationery (pens, pencils, folders, paper, notebooks)
Subject-specific equipment (e.g. art & textiles supplies)
Calculators (including scientific/graphing where required)

Travel & Transport

Daily travel to and from school
(bus passes, petrol contribution)
Travel to: Work experience placements
University/apprenticeship visits

Books & Learning Resources

Textbooks and revision guides
Set texts for English or other subjects
University/admissions test preparation materials (e.g. UCAT, LNAT, BMAT-style resources)

Trips & Visits

Curriculum-related trips (fully or partially funded depending on cost)
Fieldwork (e.g. geography, biology)
University open days (where organised or approved)

Exam & Progression Costs

UCAS application fee (via school approval)
Admissions test fees (where applicable)
Interview travel costs (university/apprenticeship)

Enrichment & Wider Participation

Educational clubs or activities
linked to study/career goals
Duke of Edinburgh or similar programmes

Work Experience Support

Travel to placement
Essential clothing or equipment
(e.g. safety boots, uniform where required)

Other Costs that directly support Learning

Any essential item not listed above that directly supports participation in education considered on a case-by-case basis at the school's discretion

Guidance/ Rules

Items are usually purchased **by the school**, not reimbursed
Must be **essential for education**
Must be **agreed in advance**
Funding may be **partial depending on cost and budget**
